



A Message from Father Aaron

Beloved Sons and Daughters

Dear Friends,

This week we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord as our Lord and Savior. He was baptized in the Jordan river by the Baptist. Jesus did not need to be baptized because he did not suffer from the stain of original sin. He was already perfect from the very moment of His conception in the womb of His Mother Mary. Why was Jesus baptized then? There are a few reasons for this. One is that Jesus chose to be baptized by John to display His brotherhood with humanity. Another reason for Christ's baptism was not that He would be sanctified, but rather, that Christ would sanctify the waters. As a few of the Saints have pointed out, it is not Christ who is baptized, it is He who baptizes the water.

As we have perhaps experienced new graces from the Christmas Season and now move on into a new year, may we let this celebration of the Lord's Baptism remind us of who we are. We are beloved sons and daughters of the Most High God. We, the children of the Father have been chosen, redeemed, and called to live in this very time in history. We are not abandoned, but rather, our Father is quite near to us. In fact, through the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, He lives in us. No matter where life may take us, or what downfall or new opportunity we are presented with in life, may we always remember that we have been created, recreated, and we belong to a great Father that loves us more than we can imagine. The prophets of old testify to the love of God. "I have loved you with an everlasting love." (Jeremiah 31:3) Or, "You are precious to me and I love you." (Isaiah 43:4) May we place all of our trust in our God of love.

In this year of 2022, may we go forth in all that we do, all that we hope for, in all our relationships, and in the challenges that we may face, with a deep belief in our identity as God's beloved children. Saint Pope John Paul II words sum it up nicely. "What really matters in life is that we are loved by Christ and that we love Him in return. In comparison to the love of Jesus, everything else is secondary. And, without the love of Jesus, everything is useless."
