
Women's Retreat

The Celebration Sunday worship service concluded with prayerful consideration of financial commitments for 2023. Thank you to all who've made a financial commitment! We're thrilled that so many have been able to raise their commitment over 2022.

Results thus far include:

- 154 commitment cards received a 45% increase over last year!
- Total pledged: \$545,116.00
- 111 raised their commitment over 2022–resulting in \$234,540.00 over last year's pledges (includes amounts from first-time commitments).


