Beloved Parishioners and Friends of St. Maron,

Peace and grace to you in the Lord Jesus, with the hope that you are all well and in good health. We give thanks to God for the little relief that we have from the Covid-19 as we see people feeling a little more comfortable to come to church and to be together, as we understand more everyday that Jesus is the most essential gift that we need in our life and receiving Him in the Eucharist is more important than anything else. We know that there is light at the end of the tunnel and we are hoping that the light of Christ will always shine upon you and guide and protect you in your life.



Now that the trial of Derek Chauvin is over we pray for our city and country, and we ask the Lord to protect all the innocent people, to grant justice to all those who seek it. 
