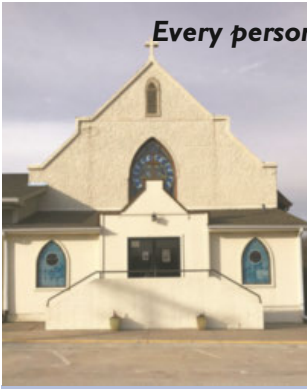
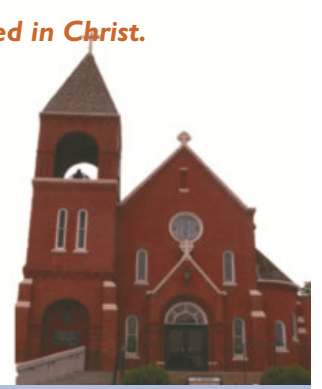

Dear Friends:

The Ten Commandments have always had a central place in the moral teaching of the Catholic Church, as among the Jewish people. They are found in two places in the Old Testament: in Exodus 20:1-17 and in Deuteronomy 5:6-21. There are slight differences between the two formulations. Not too long ago I was asked a question about the difference in the ordering or numbering of these commandments. I would like to address this issue briefly.

The Catholic tradition, with that of the Lutheran Confessions would normally use the following version (let us call it Version One):

1. You shall not have strange gods before me.
2. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.
3. Remember to keep holy the Sabbath Day.
4. Honor your father and your mother.
5. You shall not kill.
6. You shall not commit adultery.
7. You shall not steal.
8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
9. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife.
10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

Some Eastern Churches and the Reformed Protestants order or number the commandments differently as can be seen from the following version, (let us call it Version Two):

1. You shall have no other gods before me.
2. You shall not make unto yourself any graven image.
3. You shall not take the name of the Lord in vain.
4. Remember to keep holy the Sabbath Day.
5. Honor your father and your mother.
6. You shall not kill.
7. You shall not commit adultery.
8. You shall not steal.
9. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor.
10. You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, house or goods.

In Version Two, the first commandment of Version One is divided into two, then the second to eighth commandments of Version One become the third to the ninth commandments of Version Two. Then the tenth commandment of Version Two absorbs both the ninth and tenth commandments of Version One. I hope this helps to clarify this issue, next time, pay close attention to how the commandments are numbered and know which version is which. There is little point, therefore, in arguing over the fact that "*Catholic commandment number 5 does not correspond to commandment number 5 of 'the other' version.*" If these things can be soberly explained, we shall argue less, thus affording us good and wholesome health!!

Something to think about:

The Southern Ten Commandments: some people have trouble with all those 'shall's and 'shall not's' in The Ten Commandments. Folks just aren't used to talking in those terms. So, in middle Tennessee they translated the 'King James' (Version Two above) into 'Jackson County' language, here we go:

1. Just one God.
2. Put nothin' before God.
3. Watch yer mouth.
4. Git yourself to Sunday meetin'.
5. Honor yer Ma & Pa.
6. No killin'.
7. No foolin' around with another fellow's gal.
8. Don't take what ain't yers.
9. No telling tales or gossipin'.
10. Don't be hankerin' for yer buddy's stuff.

Now that's plain an' simple. Y'all have a nice day.

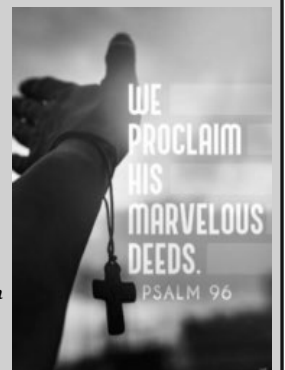

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION

First Saturdays: 2 to 3 pm at St. Patrick

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK (ANOINTING)

Anointing is available upon request for serious illness, before surgery & in emergency any time.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

To have your child baptized, you must be a registered parishioner in good standing for at least 3 months. Baptismal requests must be made at least one month before the desired date. A baptismal class is required for first time parents. Please call the office to schedule.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

To be married at the parish, you or your intended spouse or your parents must be a registered parishioner in good standing for at least six months before a date can be requested, with a minimum of six months for marriage preparation. The couple needs to talk with a priest or deacon six months before the anticipated wedding date. If a prior marriage is involved; one year notice is necessary.

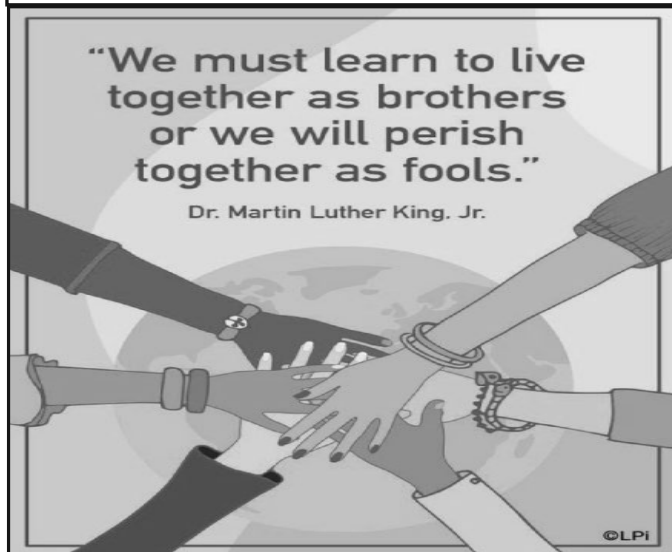
PASTORAL VISITATIONS

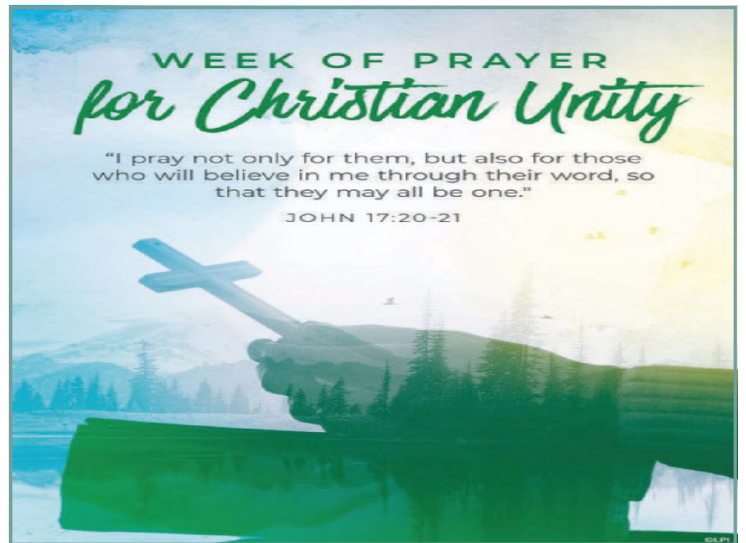

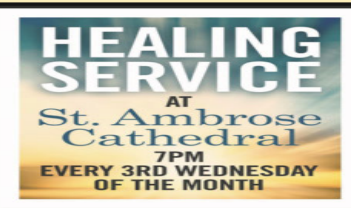

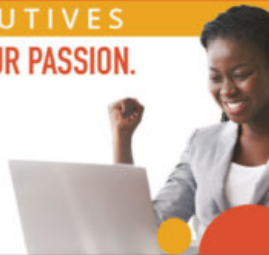
