

**Rosary Garden Update ...** 

The rosary stones are all sold and will soon go to the manufacturer to be cut and engraved!! However, if you are still wanting to be included in this project, there is opportunity to do so. We are installing a footpath down to the rosary from the upper patio area. The steps will be of the same stone material - square in shape - and can be inscribed in the same way as the beads. The cost per stone is also the same (\$340.00). Additionally, monetary contributions can also be made towards landscaping - shade trees, shrubs, and flowers. This is a huge project for our parish and one we can be very proud of!

Thank you to all who have donated or purchased stones! Installation will begin after all of the stones are delivered later this summer.

## The Annunciation of the Lord - March 25th

The Feast of the Annunciation is one of the most important in the Church calendar.

First, it celebrates the actual Incarnation of Our Savior -- the Word made flesh in the womb of His mother, Mary. Second, it is a principal Marian feast. Two other feasts honoring Our Lord's mother, the Assumption (August 15), and the Immaculate Conception (December 8), are celebrated as Holy Days of Obligation in the United States. New Year's Day, January 1, is



observed as a Solemnity of Mary.

The biblical account of the Annunciation is in the first chapter of the Gospel of St. Luke. It describes the news given to Mary that she was to become the mother of the Incarnation of God. It also records the "angelic salutation" of Gabriel to Mary, 'Hail, thou who art highly favored. The Lord is with thee." This is the origin of the repeated "Hail Mary" prayer of the Rosary and Mary's response to God's will, "Let it be done to me according to thy word." Her exultant hymn, the Magnificat, found in Luke 1:46-55, has been part of the Church's liturgy of the hours, at Vespers (evening prayer), and has been repeated nightly in churches, convents and monasteries for many centuries.

Our God loves us so much that He chose to become one of us -- to take on our humanity so completely that he "became flesh", as utterly weak and dependent as any human infant is. God became "like us in all things except sin" at the moment of His conception in Mary's womb, not at some later time. The Feast of the Annunciation is a celebration of the actual Incarnation of Jesus Christ.

We can only imagine the questions and wonder that Mary must have felt when Gabriel shared his message of a child - her child - who would "be great and will be called Son of the Most Hgh". Her immediate surrender to God's will - without knowing how it would all turn out - is a powerful example of trust and faith.

This Friday, let us remember and ponder all these things in our hearts.
