

#### The Back Page

One of the books I am currently reading is "Things Worth Dying For—Thoughts on a Life Worth Living" by Archbishop Charles J. Chaput, a Franciscan Priest and former Bishop of the Rapid City Diocese and of Philadelphia. He talks about having the courage to face martyrdom, or the judgment of a just God. He writes: "We're barely able to live up to the basic demands of the Ten Commandments. Many of us have trouble following even the minimal norms of a Catholic life: regular confession and Mass attendance, kindness to others, and a few minutes of daily prayer. If those simple things are struggles, how can we possibly have the courage to face martyrdom? Or the judgment of a just God?"

Wow... Makes a person think. How strong of a Christian am I? Willing to die for my Christian beliefs? How strong of a Catholic am I? Willing to die for my Catholic Faith? Along with the strength to die for my Christianity and my Catholic Faith, am I willing to truly live my Christianity and Catholicism? Again, as the author says, when I struggle with even the minimal norms of my Faith...

So, we can ask, what kind of Christians and Catholics are we and what kind do we want to be? Think about it. Prav about it. Do something about it...

Speaking about the minimal norms of a Catholic life, take a look at how you celebrate, participate in, and pray the Mass. A bit slow on your sitting, standing, or kneeling? Not sure of the words of the Gloria, the Creed. or the Memorial Acclamation, of which there are three options? (Could you recite all three?) If you ever notice me praying my Mass prayers a bit faster and louder, it is often a response to what I perceive to be weak, muffled, unenthusiastic responses during the Mass from you. I am trying to light a fire under you! Drives me nuts that folks who regularly go to Mass sometimes pray the Mass as if they don't really know what they are doing. Folks, when it comes to Mass, know what you are doing and do what you know. Let us all pray well!


