

The Back Page

Our celebration this weekend is The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also called Corpus Christi. Here are some things the Catholic Catechism teaches us about the Eucharist: Christ is truly, really, and substantially present in the Holy Eucharist. The entire, whole Christ, body, blood, soul, and divinity is present in the Eucharist under the appearances of both the bread and the wine. We worship Christ present in the Blessed Sacrament during the celebration of the Eucharist. We worship Christ present in the Blessed Sacrament outside of Mass through silent adoration, processions, and other devotions. The presence of Christ in the Eucharist cannot be known by our senses, but only by faith. Before receiving Holy Communion, Catholics are asked to abstain from food, liquids, and solids for one hour. Medicine and water may be taken. Non-Christians and Christians not fully united with the Catholic Church cannot receive the Eucharist. The Eucharist signifies a oneness in faith. life, and worship. Reception of the Eucharist by non-Catholics would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, for which we must all pray. The changing of the bread and the wine into the Body and Blood of Christ is known as Transubstantiation. The essential rite of the Eucharist is the consecration of the unleavened bread and wine which is accomplished by the priest when he says the words: "This is my body which will be given up for you" over the bread and "This is the cup of my blood, the blood of the new and everlasting covenant. It will be shed for you and for many so that sins may be forgiven" over the wine.

At the Last Supper Jesus said "Take, eat, this is my body. Take, drink, this is my blood." He also said "Unless you eat my body and drink my blood you shall not have life within you." Awesome... And we repeat: "The presence of Christ in the Eucharist cannot be known by our senses, but only by faith." If you are struggling with your belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, keep praying. With each reception of Holy Communion say "Lord, I believe, help my unbelief." Pray; your Faith will grow.

Father's Day! Happy Father's Day to fathers, grandfathers, expectant fathers. And prayers for those whose fathers have died. Prayers for those who grew up without a father. Prayers for those who had an abusive father, or who were abandoned by their father. One of the things prison inmates have in common is that they grew up in homes with no fathers. Statistics show that children who grow up in homes where there is a mother and a father fare far better than those homes where the father is absent. Pray for strong marriages and families. Make prayer a part of your marriage and family. Fathers—be the spiritual leaders you are called to be. Happy Father's Day!
