
SEARCH for Christian Maturity - March 1-3

Living Stewardship



Abraham was prepared to sacrifice his only son, Isaac. St. Paul reminds us that God Himself "did not spare his own Son." Are my gifts to the Lord – of my resources, of my time, of myself – also sacrificial?

This is My Beloved Son with Whom I am well pleased. Listen to Him.



The First 14 Weeks

Just 22 days after conception, a human embryo's heart begins beating. The little heart will beat nearly 54 million times *before he or she is born!*

By 6 weeks plus 2 days after conception, the brain waves of an unborn child can be recorded by EEG (electroencephalogram).

At 9 weeks after conception, unborn children begin thumb-sucking.



At just 10 weeks after conception, nails and fingerprints begin to emerge in patterns that will uniquely identify a child throughout his or her entire life.

Between 12 and 16 weeks they often touch their mouths, up to 50 times an hour.

Teeth start to grow by 13 weeks.

Beginning at 14 weeks, developmental differences between boys and girls begin to appear: female fetuses move their mouths much more frequently than males.

Fasting and Abstinence during Lent

Catholics are called to fast and abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

Ages 18-59. A fasting person is permitted one full meal and two smaller meals, not to equal a full meal.

From age 14 onward, we abstain from eating meat on all Fridays during Lent.

*Exceptions include those who are physically and mentally ill (including chronic illnesses like diabetes) as well as pregnant and nursing mothers. The Church teaches that common sense should prevail so a person does not further jeopardize his or her health because of fasting requirements. ~ Diocese of Bismarck
