La escena del libro de los Hechos de los apóstoles distingue entre el lenguaje humano y cultural, y el lenguaje del Espíritu. La descripción del Espíritu Santo, descendiendo sobre los apóstoles, facilita que el Evangelio llegue a todas las naciones, ya que todos los que estaban reunidos en Jerusalén entendían, en sus propias lenguas, el mensaje que les anunciaban. Era la lengua de la fe la que les hacía llegar, a todos por igual, la fuerza del Espíritu Santo. La segunda lectura y el Evangelio, narran los frutos del Espíritu Santo entre nosotros. San Juan lo llama, el Consolador, el Espíritu de la Verdad, y San Pablo, en la Carta a los gálatas, distingue claramente entre las obras que nacen de los corazones desordenados y egoístas; de aquellas que nacen de los frutos del Espíritu Santo. Esta distinción no sólo fue válida en el tiempo de los gálatas, es válida hoy, en nuestros tiempos.

Llenos de alegría por esta celebración que nos une en el amor y la fuerza del Espíritu Santo, hoy podemos dar gracias a Dios, por nuestra Iglesia, nuestros pastores, diáconos, ministros laicos, voluntarios; en especial por nuestro Santo Padre, el Papa Francisco, quienes animados por la presencia del Espíritu Santo proclaman el Reino de Dios en la tierra.

The Year of St. Joseph The Patron Saint of Families

Because of his role at "the crossroads between the Old and New Testament," St Joseph "has always been venerated as a father by the Christian people" (PC, 1). In him, "Jesus saw the tender love of God," the one that helps us accept our weakness, because "it is through" and despite "our fears, our frailties, and our weakness" that most divine designs are realized. "Only tender love will save us from the snares of the accuser," emphasizes the Pontiff, and it is by encountering God's mercy especially in the Sacrament of Reconciliation that we "experience His truth and tenderness," – because "we know that God's truth does not condemn us, but instead welcomes, embraces, sustains and forgives us". A father who teaches the value, dignity and joy of work "A carpenter who earned an honest living to provide for his family," St Joseph also teaches us "the value, the dignity and the joy of what it means to eat bread that is the fruit of one's own labor." This aspect of Joseph's character provides Pope Francis the opportunity to launch an appeal in favor of work, which has become "a burning social issue" even in countries with a certain level of well-being. "there is a renewed need to appreciate the importance of dignified work, of which Saint Joseph is an exemplary patron," the Pope writes.
