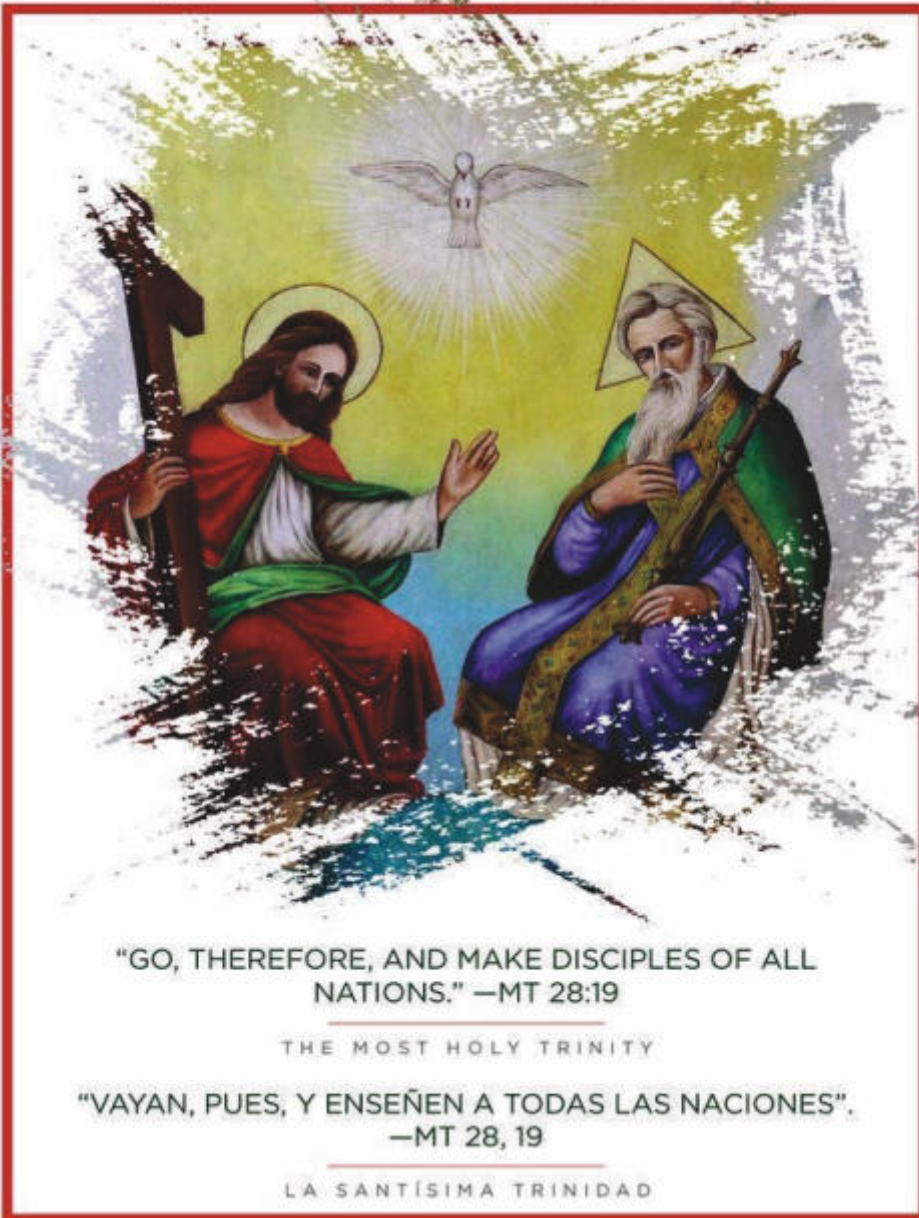

**QUE ES LA SANTISIMA TRINIDAD**

La Santísima Trinidad no son tres dioses diferentes, no es un solo Dios que se manifiesta en tres personas diferentes como dicen los paganos, la Trinidad es un solo Dios que es tres personas y cada persona es completamente Dios. La primera persona de la Trinidad es el Padre, Él es la fuente de la Divinidad y de todas las cosas. La segunda persona es el Hijo, quien es la Palabra del Padre, engendrado del Padre, no creado. La tercera persona es el Espíritu Santo que no es engendrado ni creado, procede eternamente del Padre, es guía de la Iglesia. Todos son eternos y divinos.

**ORACION A LA SANTISIMA TRINIDAD**

“Oh Dios mío, Trinidad Beatísima! Saca de mi pobre ser, el máximo rendimiento para vuestra gloria y haz de mi lo que quieras en el tiempo y la eternidad. Que yo no ponga jamás el menor obstáculo voluntario a tu acción transformadora...Segundo a segundo, con intención siempre actual, quisiera ofrecerte cuanto soy y tengo; y que mi pobre vida sea, en unión íntima con el Verbo Encarnado, un sacrificio de alabanza y gloria a la Trinidad Beatísima”. **ALGUNAS CLAVES PARA ENTENDER A LA SANTISIMA TRINIDAD**

- 1.- **Trinidad** significa un solo Dios en tres Personas distintas; Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Las tres divinas Personas son realmente distintas entre sí por sus relaciones recíprocas: El Padre engendra al Hijo, el Hijo es engendrado por el Padre, el Espíritu Santo procede del Padre y el Hijo.
- 2.- **El misterio central de la fe y de la vida cristiana** es el misterio de la Santísima Trinidad. Los cristianos somos bautizados en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo.
- 3.- **El dogma de la Trinidad** se definió en dos etapas, en el primer Concilio de Nicea (325 D. C.) en el que se definió la divinidad del Hijo y en el primer Concilio de Constantinopla (381 D.C.), se definió la divinidad del Espíritu Santo.
- 4.- **La Trinidad se sustenta** en la revelación divina dejada por Cristo. No se puede demostrar por la razón natural o únicamente desde el Antiguo Testamento.
