**CONOCE MAS SOBRE FIESTA DEL CUERPO Y SANGRE DE CRISTO
CORPUS CHRISTI**

La celebración del Corpus Christi nació de un milagro eucarístico que tuvo lugar en la ciudad de Orvieto, en Italia en el siglo XIII. Después de comprobarse este milagro, el papa Urbano IV ordenó que se celebrara la Solemnidad del Corpus Christi en toda la Iglesia, el jueves siguiente a la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad. Por cuestiones pastorales en algunos lugares esta celebración es trasladada al fin de semana siguiente. En esta solemnidad la Iglesia rinde tributo a la Eucaristía en un culto solemne de Adoración, Gratitud y Amor. Jesús Eucaristía está presente en el Sagrario todos los días, todo el día y lo ignoramos. **Jesús nos espera en la Eucaristía.** “Si no coméis la carne del Hijo del hombre y no bebéis su Sangre. No tenéis vida en vosotros.” (Juan. 6, 53)

TRES MOMENTOS IMPORTANTES DE LA EUCARISTIA

**REFLEXIÓN DE LA SOLEMNIDAD DEL SANTISIMO
CUERPO DE CRISTO**

Habría mucho que decir sobre la solemnidad tan popular que celebramos hoy. Pero es necesario que escuchemos la Palabra de Dios para poder reflexionar sobre el impacto que esta celebración causa en nuestra vida espiritual.

Las dos primeras lecturas de esta solemnidad nos ayudan a comprender mejor el tema principal de este día: la nueva Alianza que Cristo selló con su sangre como mediador entre Dios y la humanidad, para convertirse en alimento permanente de la Pascua “hasta que vuelva”.

La lectura del libro del Éxodo nos dice que así como Moisés selló la antigua Alianza al bajar del Monte Sinaí con la Sangre del Cordero que roció sobre el altar del sacrificio de la Cruz, así Cristo selló la Nueva Alianza, por el sacrificio de la Cruz y con el pan y el vino que transforma en la Última Cena, a la que hace referencia el Evangelio de san Marcos, y nos permite participar de su entrega redentora.

En la segunda lectura, la Carta a los hebreos distingue claramente que esta Alianza no es la restauración de la primera, sino una Alianza nueva que no sólo rinde culto a Dios, sino que acoge a toda la humanidad y la redime del pecado.

En las Misas de esta celebración es costumbre hacer una procesión Eucarística dentro o alrededor de la Iglesia para permitir a los fieles un tiempo de Adoración. La tradición Eucarística desde el siglo XIII sigue formando parte de la piedad de los fieles en la actualidad y ha servido a los misioneros para evangelizar y catequizar a los pueblos más alejados del mundo.
