Escuchamos, en la Primera Lectura, que Dios desea cortar las ramas del cedro para plantarla en la montana, sitio del encuentro con su pueblo, para que crezca de ellas un árbol que produzca buen fruto.

Para el pueblo de Israel, el árbol significo la figura de la mujer o el hombre justo que, plantado cerca del agua de los ríos, recibía alimento, fortaleza y vida del Señor.

En el Evangelio, Jesús utiliza la imagen del grano de mostaza para ampliar el anuncio del Reino, y ofrece a sus oyentes la oportunidad de abrazar un estilo de vida que ha de producir buen fruto entre ellos y más allá de sus experiencias.

San Pablo proclama, en la segunda lectura, que el fruto que desea el Señor proviene de poder caminar con El y experimentar las exigencias del Evangelio con valentía y dignidad. Para san Pablo, la fe siempre fue un compromiso que le permitió esperar su encuentro con Cristo, al final de su misión evangelizadora.

Hoy, nos podríamos preguntar, Cómo es nuestra confianza en las gracias de Dios, para vivir plenamente nuestro compromiso de fe? Vamos a la Iglesia, solamente, por deber o por miedo?
