**REFLEXIÓN: XXIII DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO**

Las lecturas proclaman esperanza y sanación en el pueblo de Dios. Escuchamos, en la primera lectura, que Isaías afronta el miedo de exiliados y perseguidos con la esperanza de un nuevo amanecer. El profeta anuncia que Dios se acerca a su pueblo para restaurar la visión en el ciego y claridad en el sordo. En el Evangelio vemos, que Jesús actualiza la promesa de los profetas, al sanar a un sordomudo en una región cerca de Galilea, que todos conocían como Decápolis, ( Diez Ciudades). Su gesto provoca gran entusiasmo en la muchedumbre que lo acompaña. Para Santiago, en la segunda lectura, vemos que no puede haber diferencia entre ricos o pobres, si todos viven dispuestos a seguir a Cristo. El Apóstol hace un llamado a los líderes de la comunidad porque este mandato proviene de Dios, quien escogió a los pobres del mundo para hacerlos ricos en la fe y herederos del Reino. La primera comunidad de cristianos acogió el Evangelio e introdujo en el Rito Bautismal, el gesto que Jesús utilizó para sanar al sordomudo. Como parte de los ritos opcionales del Bautismo, hoy en día, el sacerdote o diácono toca los oídos y la boca del infante bautizado, para pronunciar "Effeta" (!Ábrete!), Una llamada a escuchar y proclamar la Palabra de Dios. La esperanza de los profetas, realizada en Jesucristo, prevalece en la Iglesia que proclama al Cristo que sana las dolencias y actualiza la justicia y misericordia entre todos especialmente los pobres de espíritu. Hoy, a todos se nos hace un llamado permanente a escuchar y proclamar la Palabra de Dios.

## Attention Birth Parents:

If you placed a child in an adoptive home and you desire to remain anonymous, please read the following information carefully. Adult Adoptees can now apply for Non-certified Copy of Original Certificate of Birth. Governor Reynolds has signed new legislation that will allow an adopted adult whose original birth certificate was substituted with a new certificate after an adoption, to apply for, and obtain, a non-certified copy of the original certificate of birth, which will include biological parent information. The law also allows biological parents to file contact preference and medical history forms with the Bureau of Health Statistics in the Iowa Department of Public Health. The law will immediately apply to those who were born before 1971. Beginning Jan 1, 2022, anyone over the age of 18 can request the same document.

**If the Iowa Department of Public Health Bureau of Statistics does NOT receive your "Biological Parent of an Adoptee Contact Preference Form", your name MAY BE RELEASED.** If you want to remain anonymous, this requires your immediate attention. Contact the Bureau of Statistics directly at 515-281-7689.
