LA EXALTACION DE LA CRUZ

Cada 14 de Setiembre se celebra la Exaltación de la Cruz, en la que se muere para vivir en Dios y con Dios, para vivir en la verdad, en la libertad y en el amor, para vivir eternamente como dijo San Juan Pablo II.

Santa Elena encontró el madero en que murió Cristo en el Siglo IV cuando era Emperatriz. En el año 614 los persas la tomaron como trofeo de guerra. El emperador Heraclio la rescató y la llevó a la ciudad Santa un 14 de Setiembre del 618. Desde entonces ese día se celebra esta festividad.

Para evitar otro robo el santo madero se dividió en varios pedazos que fueron a diferentes lugares e Iglesias, uno se quedó en Tierra Santa.

La Santa Cruz nos recuerda el Amor Divino del Padre hacia nosotros y el Amor mayor de Cristo, quien dio la vida por sus amigos. La Santa Cruz es la señal del cristiano, es la síntesis del Evangelio, es el camino a la gloria, a la luz. Es la respuesta de Dios al mal.

NUESTRA SENORA DE LOS DOLORES

Se le da este nombre a la Virgen María por los sufrimientos que ella soportó como la Madre de Jesús, no por el lugar en que apareció como la Virgen de Fátima o de Lourdes.

La devoción y meditación de los dolores de la Virgen vienen desde el siglo VIII, en que se hablaba de la “compasión de la Virgen”, refiriéndose a la participación de María en la crucifixión de su Hijo.

Después surge la devoción a los 7 Dolores de la Virgen: La profecía de Simeón, La huída a Egipto, La pérdida del Niño Jesús por tres días, El encuentro de María con Jesús camino al Calvario, La Crucifixión y muerte de Jesús, María recibe el cuerpo de Jesús bajado de la Cruz y María al ver a Jesús en el sepulcro.

Fue recién en 1244 que se celebra la fiesta de Nuestra Señora de los Dolores, gracias a la Orden de los Siervos de María. Muchos años después, en 1814, fue el Papa Pío VII quien estableció que esta fiesta se celebrará el 15 de Setiembre.

REFLEXIÓN: XXIV DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Después de la primera lectura escuchamos en el Salmo, “caminar en presencia del Señor”. Nos preguntamos, qué significa eso? y en las lecturas de hoy encontramos la respuesta.

Isaías anuncia, en la primera lectura, que el Señor es la fuerza del oprimido y está cerca de los que buscan justicia. Él siempre les ayudará.

En el Evangelio, Jesús pide a sus discípulos una respuesta clara a la pregunta; “Quién soy Yo” y sólo Pedro responde como El esperaba. Los otros no reconocen al Mesías que camina cerca de ellos, quizás reconocen a un Jesús profeta, que sana a los que sufren.

Cuando les revela el misterio de su llamado, y la forma en que se va a entregar a la muerte para resucitar a una nueva vida, Pedro no lo puede aceptar, y Jesús lo calla con firmeza.

Jesús los invitan a que lo sigan, renunciando a todo y cargando la cruz de la esperanza con la que El mismo va a ser clavado.

Cuando reflexionemos preguntémonos si sentimos la presencia del Señor, su cercanía durante nuestro caminar diario, frente a los ruidos y distracciones que nos rodean. Lo que surja de estas reflexiones nos deben llevar a todos a considerar la invitación hecha por Jesús a sus discípulos: Están dispuestos a caminar con El hasta el final de la jornada?
