REFLEXIÓN: EPIFANIA DEL SEÑOR

Esta liturgia de la Epifanía, enfatiza la manifestación de Dios en Jesús, su único Hijo, como luz y vida para todas las naciones y pueblos, reflejado en la visita de los Reyes Magos, al pesebre de Belén.

En la primera lectura el profeta Isaías nos da a conocer que, el Señor, nuestra luz, ha venido a guiarnos por sus caminos, mientras que san Pablo, en su carta a los Efesios, en la segunda lectura, nos dice que no sólo los judíos, sino todos los bautizados, compartiremos la misma herencia, perteneceremos al mismo cuerpo y recibiremos las mismas promesas de Dios. En el Evangelio, el relato de los Magos adelanta la contradicción que existe entre los que buscamos a Jesús. Algunos, como los Magos, lo reconoceremos y aceptaremos, y otros como Herodes, lo rechazaremos y perseguiremos

Los pueblos hispanos, acogemos en nuestra religiosidad las imágenes de los Magos como reyes de Oriente y los reconocemos como peregrinos que se acercan al pesebre, para formar parte del conjunto escénico que rodea a la Sagrada Familia. Ambos elementos aparecen en los textos bíblicos de esta celebración.

La manifestación de Dios en Jesucristo se convierte en don y desafío. Como don, podemos participar en la herencia que Dios nos da a través de la vida sacramental de la Iglesia; como desafío estamos llamados a acoger, sin prejuicios ni distinciones, a todos los que comparten la fe y el mismo Bautismo para ser discípulos misioneros, luz y vida en la historia y la sociedad.

We received a heartwarming Christmas greeting from Theresa Patterson, Coordinator Parish Twinning of the Americas.

"As conditions in Haiti have deteriorated by the day, the desperation, chaos & suffering continues to grow. A gallon of gas is now \$30 USD or more while very little is available. Grocery stores are empty & the price of basic rice & beans has skyrocketed. Epidemic of kidnappings, criminal gangs have literally shut the country down. However, she said "in spite of this horrifying picture, I do see a glimmer of light & the promise of hope . . . in you and in so many parishes.

All we can do in this moment & time, is let them know we sympathize, we understand, and we still care for them. Our concern, & most of all prayers, will give them strength, courage and renewed hope.

We Thank all of you for your gifts, prayers & kindness, that we are able to feed and clothe the Christ who dwells in us, to find the strength to carry on. As the year comes to an end, remember your tax deductible gifts help more than you can ever imagine."
