### REFLEXIÓN: EL BAUTISMO DE JESUS

Esta solemnidad se celebra después de la Epifanía del Señor y con ella concluye el tiempo de Navidad, para abrir paso al tiempo en que palpamos de cerca el Ministerio del Señor. Marca el comienzo del Ministerio del Señor en Galilea, el anuncio del Reino de Dios.

Juan celebraba en el Jordán un rito penitencial con el agua que purificaba a los israelitas de sus pecados. Jesús, que no tenía pecado, se sometió al rito para identificarse con la humanidad pecadora.

En el Evangelio de hoy, el relato del Bautismo de Jesús nos desafía a confiar plenamente en el Hijo Amado, que el Padre señala durante el rito al que Jesús se somete con Juan en el río Jordán. Esta confianza se muestra con hechos.

En este Evangelio también se observa la sorpresa de Juan Bautista al ver a Jesús someterse a este rito que provocó el anuncio del Padre frente a toda la gente reunida. El Padre habló de su Hijo Amado en quien se complace y a quien teníamos que escuchar. Ungió a su Único Hijo, señalándolo como el camino que conduce a la eternidad a todos los pueblos.

El agua de nuestro Bautismo es el símbolo por medio del cual el Espíritu Santo nos ha abrazado; de ahí se produce nuestro renacer a la Nueva Alianza sellada por la Sangre del Señor en la Cruz. Este compromiso nos exige una vida dedicada a conocer y amar a Aquel por quien nos hemos sumergido en la fuente de la salvación, para vivir libres del pecado.

Este fin de semana hay que poner énfasis en el regalo del Espíritu Santo, que no es una paloma, aunque este es el símbolo que nos recuerda la iluminación o animación que tiene en la Iglesia, sino que es Quien, desde el Bautismo, transforma nuestra fragilidad humana y la enriquece con su presencia. La presencia del Espíritu Santo en nuestras comunidades también permitirá que sus miembros se acepten y se amen desde el Bautismo que los designa como hijos e hijas de Dios.
