### LA CONVERSION DE SAN PABLO. FIESTA: 25 DE ENERO

Saulo era enemigo de los cristianos. La primera noticia que tenemos de San Pablo es que fue el joven que asistió y consintió la muerte de San Esteban, primer mártir de la Iglesia acusado de blasfemo y que murió apedreado por los judíos. El martirio de San Esteban dio inicio a una persecución general contra la Iglesia fundada por Cristo.

Saulo nació en Tarso de Silicia y pertenecía a la tribu de Benjamín. Como ciudadano romano, poseyó una formación completa. Era un ferviente judío que odiaba a los seguidores de Cristo y los perseguía a muerte. En una ocasión, consiguió permiso para destruir la comunidad cristiana de Damasco, y en el camino se sintió cegado por una luz celestial que le derribó al suelo. En ese instante oyó una voz que le decía: "Saulo, Saulo, por qué me persigues...", era la voz de Jesús. Luego le dijo: "Levántate, entra en la ciudad y se te dirá lo que tienes que hacer..." (Hechos 9, 3-6)

Saulo ciego, fue llevado por mandato del Señor ante el jefe de la comunidad de Damasco, Ananías, quien le impuso las manos y le dijo que el Señor Jesús lo envió para que le devuelva la vista y sea lleno del Espíritu Santo. Luego fue bautizado.

Por tres años se preparó para la conversión de los gentiles. Predicando el Evangelio, proclamaba que Jesús era el Mesías y por ello los judíos decidieron matarlo, pero huyó a Jerusalén

La conversión de San Pablo nos enseña que nosotros también debemos cambiar totalmente de vida, viviendo profundamente nuestra fe, dando testimonio cristiano en el lugar que nos encontramos.

### REFLEXIÓN: III DOMINGO ORDINARIO

En los textos bíblicos de este domingo descubrimos un sentido de comunidad ejemplar.

La primera lectura narra un período de paz por el que el pueblo de Israel disfrutó de la lectura de la Ley y, guiado por sus líderes, practicó sus mandatos para mostrar su fidelidad al Señor.

San Pablo, siglos después, se dirige a los corintios con un sentido de comunidad similar. Ya no es la Ley los que los hace ser un Cuerpo, sino el Espíritu. En una forma magistral, san Pablo les muestra como cada uno de sus miembros, por el Bautismo, participa en la unidad de la Iglesia, formada por Dios en Cristo Jesús.

La Iglesia es el Cuerpo de Cristo, y cada uno de sus miembros, por el don del Espíritu Santo, ha sido llamado a colocar sus dones al servicio de los demás.

En el Evangelio, observamos como Jesús hace notar su presencia en la sinagoga de Nazaret y lee el texto de Isaías, ejerciendo así la función de Lector. Aunque Jesús no fuese aceptado por los suyos, reconoce que en Él se cumplen las Escrituras que ha proclamado.

Estas lecturas invitan a una reflexión en nuestras comunidades, especialmente a quienes ofrecen algún servicio en las parroquias, quienes deben evaluarse continuamente. Por ejemplo los lectores deben preguntarse si se dan cuenta que están proclamando o están leyendo.
