SOBRE LA JUVENTUD: No se olviden que no son el mañana, no son el “mientras tanto”, sino el ahora de Dios. “No tengan miedo”, vayan adelante con esa energía renovadora y esa inquietud constante que nos ayuda...a ser más “testigos del Evangelio”.

SOBRE EL AMOR: Tenemos la seguridad de saber que hemos sido amados con un amor profundo que no queremos y no podemos callar, y que nos desafía a responder de la misma manera: con amor. Es el Amor de Cristo el que nos mueve. Podremos poner todo, pero si falta la pasión del amor, faltará todo. Dejemos que el Señor nos enamore! Acaso alguien por ser discapacitado o frágil no es digno de amor? Alguien por ser extranjero, por haberse equivocado, por estar enfermo o en una prisión no es digno de amor. Sólo lo que se ama puede ser salvado. Sólo lo que se abraza puede ser transformado. Sólo el amor nos vuelve más humanos, más plenos. Hoy dejen que Jesús cambie algo en ustedes. Confíen en El y déjenlo entrar, no se decepcionarán.

REFLEXIÓN: V DOMINGO ORDINARIO

Los fieles que escuchan la Palabra asiduamente se pueden identificar con las lecturas de este domingo. En ellas notamos un cierto movimiento que nos afecta a todos: Desde el llamado bautismal al ministerio, de la vocación a la acción y al servicio.

En la primera lectura escuchamos el llamado del joven Isaías en el templo, quien, a pesar de sus excusas iniciales, acepta la misión que Dios le confía, de ser su profeta respondiendo: “Aquí estoy, envíame.

Escuchamos en la segunda lectura a Pablo exhortando a sus seguidores a permanecer fieles al Evangelio; que Cristo murió por nuestros pecados y resucitó al tercer día. Pablo se considera “indigno de llamarse apóstol”, El Señor lo bendijo con una gran misión.

En el texto del Evangelio de san Lucas, Jesús aparece en la barca de Simón y escucha sus frustraciones porque no ha pescado nada durante la noche, A pesar de ello, Simón Pedro confía en la Palabra del Señor y echa las redes mar adentro. La pesca enorme que recoge no es tan importante como la profesión de fe que hace el apóstol de rodillas delante de Jesús y las palabras finales del Señor: “No temas; desde ahora serás pecador de hombres”.

Evidentemente, estas lecturas nos invitan a reflexionar sobre nuestra vocación de servicio. Sería conveniente darle mayor importancia en nuestras comunidades, a las vocaciones sacerdotales y religiosas que casi nunca se trata y desempeñan un papel esencial en nuestra Iglesia.

Why Mass Intentions?

The origins of this practice date back to the early Church. As to why Masses are requested in the first place, we as Catholics believe that the Mass is the most powerful form of prayer there is, and can be offered for any number of intentions, including most often for a loved one, living or deceased. It is an awesome gift to give to someone, and the very best thing one can do for those who have died.

Any individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died.

Mass Intentions are needed at all Parishes. To submit your Mass Intentions please call the church office so it can be recorded as you desire. The suggested stipend is \$10 for each intention.

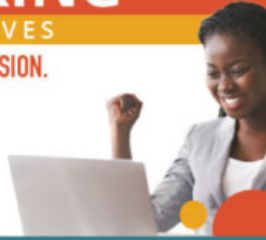
