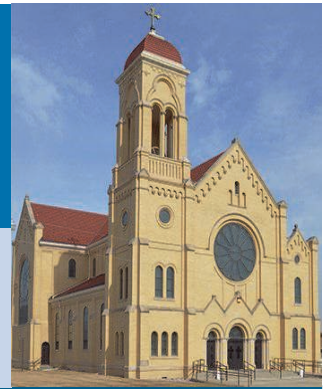

The word "catechesis" means "to echo." Literally, we are to echo the good news of Jesus Christ to the world. This is not a suggestion; it is a command of our Lord. Some people are called and set apart in our communities as catechists, those formally trained and charged with passing on the Gospel to children and adults, inside and outside of our communities. On Catechetical Sunday, we acknowledge them and remind ourselves of the need for formation and growth in all of us. To be a catechist is a privileged calling, and today be sure to say "thank you" to one in your community.

However, it would be wrong on this day to only look to those bearing the NAME of catechist for an echoing of good news. ALL of us are called to echo and share the Gospel message. Parents are the first and primary catechists in a child's life. But we also are important catechists in the lives of our coworkers, our spouses, our relatives, and our friends. Some say catechesis begins in the home, and while that is true, it carries with it a parent/child connotation. But where does catechesis really begin? It begins in the HEART. This year on Catechetical Sunday, may your heart be moved to motivate you to share with others the good news of Jesus Christ.

## FROM THE PASTOR

To drop the game winning touchdown would be very disappointing, yet to have teammates reassure the tight end that it was not totally his fault for losing the game would be a tremendous relief—a gift of mercy. This is one example of what the Scriptures illustrate on the **Twenty Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time**. Beginning with the first reading from the book of Exodus, we hear how God is upset at the sinful ways of the Israelites. On the mountain, God informs Moses of his intention to let his wrath blaze up and consume them for their idolatry. However, Moses intercedes on their behalf and reminds God of his great promise made to Abraham, Isaac and Israel. Fortunately, God relents and does no harm to the people. Even the second reading from St. Paul to Timothy accents God's wonderful generosity of mercy and grace granted to Paul, when he felt undeserving. This theme of forgiveness continues with three parables found in chapter 15 of St. Luke's gospel. These parables are only found in Luke's account, and each one stresses the incredible patience, unfathomable mercy and unconditional love of God, during times of sin and negligence. One other attribute discovered along with mercy is the hidden joy that God savors when sinners repent or embrace conversion. All three parables end with that perspective, **"Rejoice with me, because I have found my lost sheep.....rejoice with me because I have found the coin that I lost...we must celebrate and rejoice, because your brother was dead and has come to life again; he was lost and has been found."** Acknowledging our sins is not fun, but our gracious and merciful God is always willing to grant us a second chance and rejoice that we desire to make a change! Can you recall a time when God called you to change your life and feast on his mercy?

**Thank you** to all our Catechists, teachers and all volunteers who help spread and nurture the treasure of faith with our children and youth as we recognize them on Catechetical Sunday! Your caring efforts and dedication are appreciated. May God Bless you and be assured of my prayers!
