"Love is patient, love is kind ..." As familiar as these words are, they never seem to stray into the territory of becoming trite or silly. At their core they communicate a truth about us and about our Creator that never fails to inspire.

But despite the fact that you've probably heard it at many weddings over time, First Corinthians isn't just for newlyweds. It wasn't written for married folks. It's for every single one of us, in every state of life and every social situation, in every country and culture and language across the globe.

Which means that First Corinthians is even for the online world. It's for Facebook and Twitter and Instagram and all the other platforms I'm forgetting (there seems to be a new one every day, doesn't there?).

A sense of division — whether rooted in politics, culture or anything else — is growing in our world, and it's never more obvious than when we observe interactions online. It is far easier, after all, to remember what love is when a human being of flesh and blood stands before us. When all we see is an avatar or a profile picture on a screen — especially accompanied by an opinion with which we vehemently disagree — even the most loving Christians can throw First Corinthians out the window.

As everyday stewards we know that we are charged to be not only gracious but grateful. We receive others but we also give thanks for what they bring to us — even if that's an opportunity to "strive eagerly for the greatest spiritual gifts."

So before the next time you post anything online, I suggest giving First Corinthians a read — and remember, love never fails.

FROM THE PASTOR

The weather could be a factor, circumstances, an unexpected emergency, or new information could be reasons why we might change our mind about a decision we made. I confess that after praying about some important decision and sleeping on it, I have changed my mind. These are examples which might assist us to reflect on the Scriptures on **the Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time**. The first reading from the prophet Jeremiah tells how God had planned to make him a prophet as he was being formed in the womb. In addition, God had hoped that Jeremiah would be brave and share the message of God, articulating the wisdom of God's covenant and calling people, the priests, and the kings to honor the ways of God even though there would be resistance or hardship. As the passage concludes, we hear about the reassurance of God: **"They will fight against you but not prevail over you, for I am with you to deliver you, says the Lord."** This sentiment links us to Luke's gospel selection, which continues from last week as Jesus began his public ministry in Galilee and Nazareth. We remember that Jesus read from the scroll in the synagogue, and his family and others of his native place started to have a change of heart and expressed negative reactions. They were learning to hear the truth about the mission of Jesus, who was to announce God's kingdom and call people to conversion. Their expectations of him and his background as the Son of God and Joseph's son were judged and considered suspect even as Jesus challenged them to seek the path of faith and salvation. In our own day, one might wonder why Jesus, a parent, a teacher, a coach, a doctor, a pastor, a deacon or someone else of authority might invites another to change or strive for a higher goal. St. Paul, in the second reading from Corinthians, emphasizes that while faith, hope and love (theological virtues) are permanent and inseparable, it is love that remains persistent and moves another toward union with God. This is exactly the love Jesus taught and modeled for everyone by his bold words of teaching and compassionate ways of mercy. When reflecting on your spiritual life, where is Jesus calling you to change your perspective of someone or yourself? Have you been reluctant to recognize God's love for those who are not like you? Where have you experienced God's comfort you feel afflicted or in distress?

As we celebrate *Catholic School's Week*, let us rejoice in our call to grow as disciples; be grateful to our principal, teachers, staff and benefactors; and encourage one another to reveal the light and hope of Christ in our world!

Please be aware that I am going to take a week off for some personal time. If you need assistance, please contact one of our great deacons, who will help you.

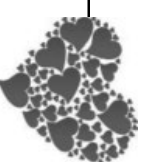

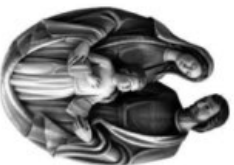

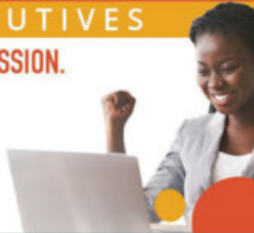
