**March 6
 First Sunday of Lent**

In the Our Father, we pray “and lead us not into temptation.” Why would we need to ask God to lead us not into temptation? It just does not sound right or feel like this would be an appropriate act of God. Then we have today’s readings. After Jesus has been baptized, He is lead into the desert to be tempted. How do we explain this?

Jesus is embarking on His ministry. He wants to draw closer to God. We know it is through fasting and prayer we can ourselves draw closer to God. Fasting is especially difficult because every crumb, every morsel of food becomes a temptation. And Jesus is not the first to be led into the desert. Moses and Elijah both entered into barren desert to learn God’s will.

Forty days and forty nights — we enter into our Lent. True you can just let it slip by. But you get out of it what you put into it. Starting with Ash Wednesday we are asked to think about our humanity. You are dust and to dust you shall return. We are tempted this Sunday. We will see the Transfiguration next Sunday. Give up something then and be sure to offer the sacrifice to God. Begin a new Bible study or start a novena, sacrifice the fruits of your efforts to God. And through it all purify your hearts and minds for the coming Passover. Be ready to celebrate Easter morning. Most importantly, pray. Psalm 91 has a verse we should all remember and say every day. *Be with me Lord, when I am in trouble; Be with me Lord, I pray.*



QUESTION AND ANSWER

Question: Is gossip a mortal sin?

Answer: To really ask this question, we must consider the Eighth Commandment: "You shall not bear false witness."

In its reflections on this commandment, The Catechism of the Catholic Church invites us to not only think about what bearing "false witness" means, but to also consider how we understand the truth and how we communicate more broadly.

This is why so much of this section of the Catechism has to do with the gift of language. With this in mind, we will notice that the word "gossip" isn't used by

the Catechism. Instead, we find the words "detraction" and "calumny," which are actually two forms that gossip can take, and both can be quite serious.

First, detraction is the revealing of "another's faults and failings to persons who did not know them," without morally valid reasons. Calumny, by extension, is saying something about another person that is untrue, and it is sinful because it "harms the reputation of others and gives occasion for false judgments" (see no. 2477).

In all of our communication, we have to always recognize that we have a moral obligation to the truth and to always

work to protect the reputation and honor of our neighbors (see no. 2479).

Gossip can, in fact, prove to be a very serious sin. After all, the Catechism reminds us: "No one is bound to reveal the truth to someone who does not have the right to know it" (no. 2489). When we have gossiped, especially if we are aware we have damaged another person's good name or reputation, we want to make every effort to undo the damage we have done, including seeking the grace and forgiveness offered in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Dear Holy Trinity, St. John's, Our Lady of Lourdes, and St. Joseph parishioners,

It is crazy to think that I have been gone for over a year and half. In that time I was out in Newport, RI for training and then December of 2020 landed in Japan to take over the Roman Catholic pastoral responsibilities of the Yokosuka Naval Base Chapel program. This base has over 26,000 personnel associated with it. Huge pastoral need. I am grateful for the Diocese letting me serve, and know that your sacrifice is a blessing for many in the military who are able to regularly receive the sacraments. I had intended on sending you this letter shortly after I left, but I procrastinated a little long. I wanted to thank you for your generosity in so many ways. Thank you for putting up with me for 3 years and helping me to learn and grow in so many ways.

I am sorry that we weren't able to have an official gathering when I left due to COVID, but I am grateful for the ability to say good bye to so many before I left. As I was leaving, many asked if they could stay in contact. Yes, please. My phone number will still work, but the better method is my email frsamuelamd@gmail.com (but just remember I am good at procrastinating). Sending mail through USPS (not UPS or Fedex) is normal postage (although it may take much longer than normal), however you will need to fill out a customs form if it is anything more than a letter.

I will be spending between 6 to 30 years in the US Navy. I do not know how long it will end up being due to many factors. I do, however, know that at the end of my time in the Navy, I will be returning to the Diocese of

Superior. This parish cluster will always be a special place for me. When I left, I was grateful and still am grateful to know that you will not only have the very capable and pastoral hands of Fr. Ed, but also have Fr. Adam Laski who is a dear friend and, in my estimation, a phenomenal priest because of his striving for holiness that helps me and all those around him.

Lastly, thank you again, for these past three years. You all are awesome! I will be praying for you all. Please say a prayer for me especially before the Most Blessed Sacrament in Adoration.
