

To understand the Transfiguration, we need to look to the first reading. It is about Abraham and the covenant established between God and Abraham. God began by seeking out humanity. God wants us with Him for all eternity. But we fall short. Think of the covenants we have broken, the many times we turn away from God. The most notable covenant is the one established through Moses. God comes down to lead His people away from slavery to the Promised Land. Moses is almost an unwilling leader as he is so humble. But through God's direction Moses leads the people through the Red Sea, 40 years in the desert, but not into the Promised Land. Joshua will be the one to lead the people now.

Now, Moses and Elijah appear to Jesus in His Transfiguration. What are they talking about? The exodus Jesus will take. The mission of Jesus is to take away the slavery of sin we are all bound to. As Moses led the people through the Red Sea and the desert, Jesus will lead us through the waters of baptism to eternal life. Just as Moses shows the Hebrew people the way, Jesus shows us the way. It is through His death, resurrection, and ascension. A promise to all of us that when we follow Jesus, we learn to die to self to rise again with Jesus.

At least that is what we hope to do. Notice what happened to the disciples. In all this beauty and amazing grandeur, they fall asleep. Awakening in time to catch a final glimpse of the glory. They will fall asleep again when Jesus asks them to stay and pray. But they will not miss the final glory of His Resurrection when He again appears in a glorified body. This is our hope and our faith that one day we, too, will join Him with a glorified body through the resurrection.
