

### March 27 - Fourth Sunday of Lent

Today is the second scrutiny for our catechumens preparing for the Easter celebration. What a perfect gospel reading. Faith and light. The Man Born Blind was condemned by the Pharisees as they announced that he was born totally in sin. Well, guess what, we are all born totally in sin, original sin. It is amazing to me how often people will say something hurtful, only to condemn themselves.

Jesus performs a miracle, and their hearts are so hard, so cold, nothing can change their way of thinking. The man's parents, even they will not acknowledge the miracle. How can you be so cold as to not celebrate your blind son now being able to see? As scripture suggests, they do not want to lose their status in the temple. But their son can see, he has seen the light. Why choose to live in darkness?

This thought of light. In a couple of weeks, we will be celebrating the Triduum (Tree – du – um). What is this? The three holiest days of the year.

It begins with Holy Thursday, the night of the Last Supper. Here the light is focused on the beginning of the Eucharist, Holy Communion. And to have Holy Communion you will need priests. Jesus gives us Holy Communion, and the priesthood in the same evening. The light has burst forth from the darkness.

Good Friday we celebrate the cross. Even in the darkest moments of the life of Christ the cross shines through with a brilliance comparable to the beginning of creation.

And that is what happens with the Easter Vigil. We begin with a celebration of light. A new fire is lit. Jesus has come to earth and has gone through the exodus of death and is resurrected. We are no longer a people of darkness. We are a people of light. Prepare to attend these holiest of holy days.

### WHAT'S A SEDER MEAL?

- The traditional Passover Week dinner celebrated by the Hebrews since the Exodus.
- A Bible Study in a family setting using all five senses to make the study an unforgettable event.
- That famous dinner called the Last Supper hosted by Jesus for his disciples.
- The Feast of the Unleavened Bread.
- The basis for the early Church's Lord's Day worship service. Referred to as the Agape Feast and the Eucharist. Agape is the Greek word for "love." Eucharist is the Greek word meaning, "Give thanks to God."

We honor our Jewish heritage by remembering the Passover, and we celebrate Jesus giving us the Eucharist on that night. Our Lady of Lourdes began celebrating the Seder in 1976, our centennial year. Our then pastor, Fr. Kraker, along with our historian Martha Mullen and sacristan Marguerite Howarth researched the ceremony, the prayers and the food prepared for this celebration.

There were very few resources available at that time. One was the pamphlet, "The Pascal Meal" from Abbey Press. Another was a program called, "The Seder Meal" published by the Liturgical Commission of the Dioceses of Savannah, GA. The first Seder Meal was held at the rectory at Fr. Kraker's dinner table with about eight people in attendance.

### St. Joseph School Students Hit the Mark!

For nearly 2 months our 7th- and 8th-grade students have prepared for the biggest project of the school year: The Bird and Mammal Presentations. Each student is asked to complete a 10-12-page research paper, a diorama on their chosen subject, and a 10-15 minute presentation, including the creation of google slides for that presentation. 7th-grade students chose a mammal to research while 8th-grade students chose a bird to research.

In January, the teachers kicked off this assignment. They asked students to decide which bird/mammal they wished to research. Since duplication of presentations is not allowed, they needed to collaborate as a class to decide who would research which subject. Sometimes the old-fashioned, friendly game of Rock Paper Scissors determined what bird/animal the student researched.

This project is interdisciplinary. Interdisciplinary projects are created by the middle school teaching team, and they are based on a theme meaningful to students. Sr. Claudine

(Language Arts), Mrs. Auriana Hyllested (Science) and Mrs. Christie Nielsen (Computers) are the teachers who guided students through this assignment. As such, the grade they receive for this project impacts multiple classes, including language arts, science and computer class. Typically, a presentation like this is done at the high school or college level. This makes the completion of this project a major accomplishment for our students.

One of the most challenging parts of this project is presenting in front of their peers. The students gain academic skills like how to research, writing skills and speech. They also learn responsibility, time management, creativity, planning and organizing skills. Building confidence in students was a major goal of our teachers through this assignment. On the day of their presentation, students dressed professionally, as they would for a job interview. Congratulations to our 7th- and 8th-grade students on their bird and mammal presentations!
