

May 15 - Fifth Sunday after Easter

This new thing, Christians, is really growing. Several hundred at this location, another thousand somewhere else. As Christians we would say we can see the hand of God in all this. What you should note is that those who are converting are not necessarily the Jewish community. Jesus told the disciples to go to the Jewish people, the children of God first, but they are stiff-necked and belligerent in many ways. Often, they threaten the disciples, and they must flee for their lives. Even we must admit, when people are threatening to us or treat us with no respect we would flee also. Now hundreds of Gentiles and pagans are converting to the faith. Over the centuries we have recognized that all people have a hunger for God. And God is working through His disciples. But there is another viewpoint, that I do not often understand. Some people would say that God had nothing to do with this spread of Christianity. Instead, this is just another religious cult taking root and gaining favor with the people. Teaching love, kindness, and respecting one another would always have a favorable impact on those listening. I think this id still prevalent in today's world, too. Rather than acknowledging God working in our lives people try to rationalize religion to be what they want it to be. That is a religion where there is no God, only god as they create him to be. These would be people who do not often come to church, are not interested in the sacraments but still live relatively good and decent lives. They will make comments such as I do not belong to a church or subscribe to any denomination, but I am spiritual. They are thinking of their created god, not the God of creation. They will often turn to the pagan gods of the past, nature, I see god in nature. Or an internal god that they find through their meditation. The gods of thousands of years are still with us today. They are searching because God put the seed of faith in all people. As Christians, let us not judge, but continue to invite them to search for the true God.


