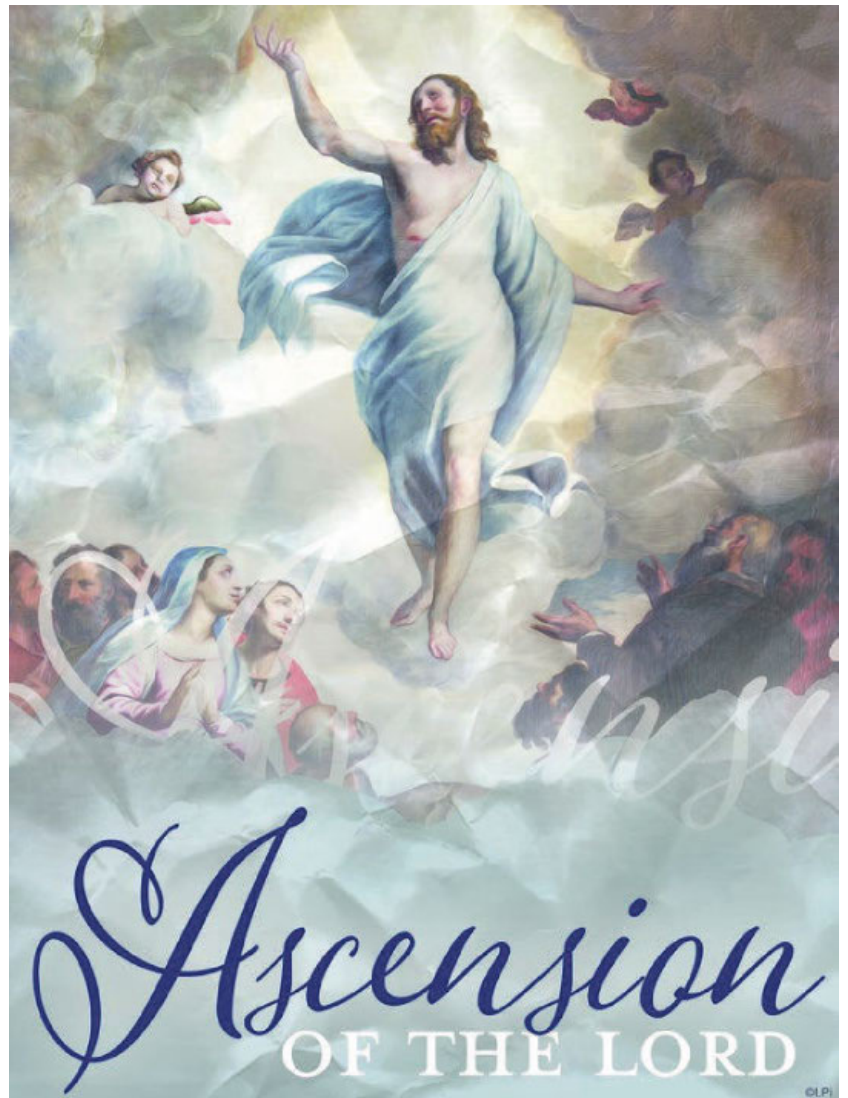

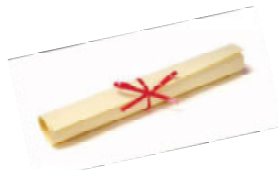

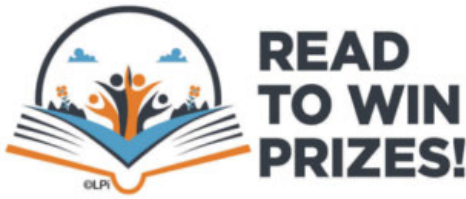

St. Joseph Parish & Finance Council Joint Meeting May 10, 2022

Minutes Summary

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 by Chairman Jeff Pierce.

The following members were present: Fr. Ed Anderson, Fr. Adam Laski, Jeff Pierce, Rick Vesper, Aaron Hendricks, Carolyn Morgan, Sarah Larson, Mike Korvoza, Jack Nelson, Jason Saffert, David Dickey and Liz Johnson.

Fr. Ed led the opening prayer.

There was a discussion on hiring of a new business manager to take Aaron Hendricks' position. There are three candidates from which one will be chosen soon.

There are currently no candidates to fill the position being vacated by Leah Kurzynski for Religious Ed Coordinator. All programs are in position to be carried on.

There are four candidates to fill the vacant Parish Council positions. A general election will be set up to elect from these four: Romaine Quinn, Mary Hagen, Sue Haughian and Dale O'Dell.

Cemetery project update was given by Jeff Pierce. Dave Putnam is currently preparing the area for the pavers to be installed. We will also be pouring a concrete pad for installation of a Pergola and small altar where committal services can be held. The memorial to the Unborn will be repaired and a new base installed which will raise it up. Someone is needed to coordinate planting the areas around the columbarium and walkways. We are pricing benches for these areas, as well.

The Cemetery Rules Committee has almost completed their revisions.

An update by Rick Vesper from the Environmental Enhancement Committee was presented to bring the Finance Council up to speed on that project. No decisions have been made. We are still in the basic planning stage getting renderings to present to the Parish.

Fr. Ed appointed Jeff Pierce as Project Manager. He will do periodic checks to see what repairs or updates need to be made to the grounds and buildings to keep things from going into disrepair.

There was a preliminary discussion about the rectory housing more and more office space and not being a proper residence for the Priests. This will be something that needs to be looked at in the not-too-distant future.

A closing prayer was read by all.

Meeting was adjourned until June 28, 2022, at 6:30.
