



Kickoff to the National Eucharistic Revival Held in Rice Lake

On Sunday, June 19, the Four Parish Catholic community including Holy Trinity (Haugen), Our Lady of Lourdes (Dobie), St. John the Evangelist (Birchwood) and St. Joseph (Rice Lake) held a cluster-wide Mass and Eucharistic Procession. This was held in honor of the Feast Day of Corpus Christi and National Eucharistic Revival kickoff.

The Mass was held outdoors in the St. Joseph Catholic School field in Rice Lake, WI. Over 300 parishioners from each of the four parishes were in attendance. The Mass was celebrated by three priests, Father Ed Anderson, Father Adam Laski and Father Dave Oberts. Deacon Isaiah Schick and Rod Knight (will be ordained a Deacon in August) along with seven altar servers assisted with the Mass. The Fourth Degree Knights of Columbus Councils 2137 and 9546 attended in full regalia.

Following the Mass, an hour-long procession took place through downtown Rice Lake. Our most recent first communicants were invited to lead the procession. Along the procession route, each parish community decorated an altar for the monstrance to be displayed on while parishioners shared their witness of how adoration has been fruitful in their lives. Those that shared expressed the significant difference they feel about their daily lives following adoration. Blessings such as the adoption of children, peace after loss of a brother and answered prayers have been life-changing fruits of those who adore Jesus on a weekly basis.

Between each altar Hail Marys were prayed while the crowd processed. Thank you to the 30+ volunteers who worked together to celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi and the kickoff to the National Eucharistic Revival.

In the Four-Parish cluster, we host two 24/7 adoration chapels: St. Joseph Church (Rice Lake) and Our Lady of Lourdes (Dobie). Our prayer is that the National Eucharistic Revival will be a way to increase the number of adorers for our chapels and to educate the faithful on the true presence and fruits of Jesus.
