



March 19 - Fourth Sunday of Lent

How important sight is. In the seminary, there was a young man who was discerning to become a priest. I recognized that he would have to memorize everything. Yes, there are Roman Missals and lectionaries in Braille, but you must till depend on your memory for many things. For example, to navigate the hallways to his room and the lecture room and chapel he counted his steps. He knew how many steps there were from his room to the stairwell, how many steps on the stairway, and how many steps from there to the classroom. He recognized the heat and cold when he passed in front of a door or window. He could 'see' through his other senses. I think of the blind man in today's reading. Before being healed he would 'see' Jesus through the sound of His voice. He would have felt the power of Jesus' hands putting mud on his eyes. He would smelled Jesus being so close to him. When the blind man regained his sight, he already knew Jesus. He saw Jesus in a new light. This is the Son of Man. Whereas the Pharisees wanted to deny Jesus and His miracles, they were blinded. The blind man's parents accepted the blindness of the Pharisees.

You have the same choice. To see Jesus is to see Him in your heart, always with you. Anything else is to choose blindness and death.
