FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

March 26 - Fifth Sunday of Lent

Jesus raised the little girl. He had been told she had died but He insisted she was sleeping. Lazarus, too, was given life because Jesus saw him sleeping. Why does God see our death as we just being asleep? We are fearful of death. In our simple way of thinking it is so powerful. The end of everything. It is final. But God tells us it is not the end, it is not final. God teaches that what looks like death to us is just our sleeping to Him. He awakens us to something greater than life on this earth. Much greater. God is the God of the living and the dead. How can the dead have a God? If they are dead why do they need a God? Lets use the words of Jesus - they are not dead they are just sleeping. Jesus calls them forth to new life with Him.

Then what about we who are in this world? Are we with our Lord or are we dead because of sin? When we sin, we are no longer with God, we are as good as dead. God has provided an opportunity for us to reconcile with Him. He waits for us to open the tomb of our hardened hearts and turn to Him. How do we roll away the stone from our hearts? We begin by opening the door to the confessional. Even with all your sins Jesus does not see you as dead. Oh, my no. He sees you asleep. Jesus says to you, Arise, come out. Hear the words of the sacrament, "I absolve you from your sins."

The Living Stations gives a unique perspective and interpretation of the events portrayed in the Stations of the Cross. You will see and hear liveaction scenes of what our Lord endured before He gave His life for us on the cross. After many months of research, deliberation and prayer, Bishop James P. Powers authorized the release of the names of clergy with substantiated allegations of abuse of a minor in



the Diocese of Superior. This information is available on the Diocesan Web site <u>www.catholicdos.org</u> and was published in the November 24, 2022 edition of the Catholic Herald. The majority of names on this list are deceased and pose no further danger. Those who are living have been removed from all priestly ministry.

The following priests have either served in our cluster at some point or grew up in the area: Thomas Erickson, Joseph Higgins, James Kraker, Gerald Mahon and Timothy Svea.

Bishop Powers and his staff are aware that the publication of these names may move additional victims to come forward. The Diocese of Superior is open to receiving these calls. To make a report, please contact Coordinator of Assistance Kathy Drinkwine as shown:
