

PASTOR'S DESK

Fourth Sunday of Easter - April 30

Cut to the heart! Reminds me of another old rock song. "Cut to the heart, and you're to blame. You give love a bad name." I think everyone remembers a time when they were cut to the heart. For the Jewish people in the first century, they are amid a prophecy being fulfilled. With Moses, the covenant was established through circumcision; but Moses foresees the day when their hearts will be circumcised, cut to the heart; and then sprinkled with water, baptism. God, Himself, has become the Shepherd. Reread the 23rd Psalm. Listen to the references for future sacraments. Besides running waters, a table laid before you and our head anointed with oil, God has given you a choice: to choose life or death. Thomas says we don't know the way; but we do. We listen to the Shepherd's voice. He guides us through the valley of death to eternal life. Jesus, I trust in you. Change my heart of stone to a heart of flesh to know and love you. I follow you and obey your commands because I love you and desire to be with you. I am not forced. I am not threatened. I am loved. - Father Ed Anderson
