

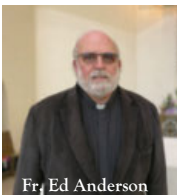

When I see the word Samaria, several stories come to mind. First, Jesus is passing through Samaria and the people do not help him or His disciples. James and John want to call down fire to consume the people. Second, the Good Samaritan parable. Even though the person hurt is Jewish the Good Samaritan helps him. Remember at that time Samaritans and Jews would have nothing to do with one another. He has compassion. Third, the Woman at the Well is a Samaritan. How many times do the Samaritans recognize Jesus when his own people do not. Can it be those who are outcasts, the downtrodden, and the lowly are given the grace to recognize Jesus when He enters their lives? It is obvious the Jewish leaders turn away from Jesus in almost every encounter. Jesus doesn't fit the model of Messiah they have mentally created. The Jewish leaders remain in the darkness. They will not accept the light Jesus brings into the world.

The message Jesus brings today is one of love. If you love Him, you love the Father. Jesus encourages us to remain in His love. Did not the Samaritans show compassion in these parables? It will take time but eventually they learn to love the Lord. And after the Resurrection of Jesus, they are not only baptized but are prepared to receive the Holy Spirit. Jesus final prayer is that we all become one. Apparently, the Samaritans accepted this teaching while the Jewish leaders could not. The question remaining is what do you believe? -Fr. Ed Anderson



## CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD


From *Update from Stephanie Hurtubise*

Lent and Easter are full and beautiful seasons for the children and catechists of Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. Lent begins with the Burying of the Alleluias, where the children decorate a piece of paper with “Alleluia” on it and then “bury” them in a box. We recall that this word of praise will not be said until that great feast that we are preparing for. The materials shown during Lent include the Last Supper, where we listen intently for those special word Jesus spoke for the first time at the Passover meal; the City of Jerusalem, where we recount the last few days of Jesus’s life on earth; the parable of the Dying Seed, when Jesus told his disciples that “unless a grain of wheat falls to the ground and dies, it remains just a grain of wheat. But if it dies, it bears much fruit.” Easter is celebrated with the Liturgy of Light, in which the Atrium Easter candle is prepared and the light of the risen Christ is shared with the children by giving them each a lit candle. The Alleluias are unburied and we sing many versions of Alleluia! The joy of the risen Christ is tangible in this celebration. During the season of Easter the children are shown the Empty Tomb work and the many different elements of the sacrament of Baptism. The CGS year ends with a celebration of Pentecost.

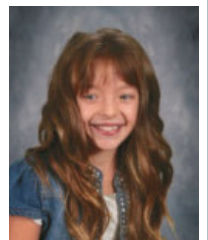

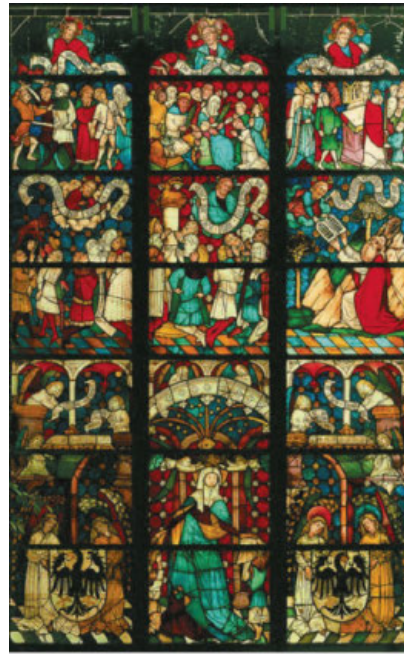
