

PAROCHIAL ADMINISTRATOR'S LETTER



Dear Brothers & Sisters,

Beginning from the time of his birth in 1920 until his death in 2005, the life of Saint Pope John Paul II was filled with some incredible events. He endured the Nazi occupation of Poland during which he secretly studied for the priesthood. He was

ordained a priest in 1946, a bishop in 1958, and appointed a cardinal in 1967. He took part in the Second Vatican Council (1962-1965). He was elected Pope in 1978. He endured an attempt on his life in 1981 and soon after met with his would-be assassin to forgive him. St. John Paul II wrote dissertations, encyclicals and visited people around world until he died in 2005.


For us, any of these following events would likely be for us "a" if not "the" defining moment of our life. What was the defining moment of John Paul II's life? When someone asked St. John Paul II what the most important day of his life was, he did not answer with any of the events previously mentioned. His response was, "The day I was baptized."

This is the event we celebrate today. Jesus, God-made-man, plunges into the Jordan river so that when you and I were plunged into the font and died to ourselves, we met Jesus there in the waters and let the Father raise us up in the power of the Spirit, so that our life is one of radical dependence on Him, the same radical Life of self-surrender and self-gift enjoyed by the Trinity. Every time we dip our fingers in the font, we are dying to self-life and entering New Life.

The gift of this "doorway" into Life is what our beloved parish gives to us...it is why the baptistry is placed at the north door, ushering us into a life of communion and self-sacrifice. It is this sacramental wellspring that is the deepest gift we treasure and pass on at St. Raphael's. When Pope John Paul II visited his childhood church in Wadowice, Poland, he went straight to the baptismal font, knelt, and kissed it. Why? Because it was there that the most important event of his life took place. As George Weigel put it, "The day of his baptism was, literally, the font from which everything else in his life flowed."






