This Sunday we celebrate Christ the King. The Solemnity of Christ the King was instituted in 1925 by Pope Pius XI in his encyclical *Quas primas*. It was a response to the growing secularism and nationalism of the time. It was written in the aftermath of World War I and in the wake of the fall of several European kingdoms.

Jesus is "King of kings and Lord of lords" (Revelation 19:16). While human kingdoms might rise and fall, the Kingdom of God will endure. May Christ always reign in our minds, in our wills, in our hearts, and in our bodies.

On the Sunday of Christ the King I will be attending the final Mass at St. Matthew the Apostle parish in south Kansas City. St. Matthew's was the first parish that I was pastor of, and I have several fond memories from my time and the people there. St. Matthew's is being amalgamated into Our Lady of the Coronation parish in Grandview.

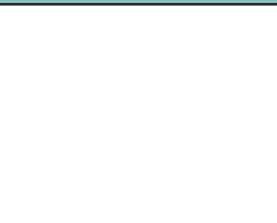
