

Good People of Good Counsel,

Next week (Monday – Friday) both myself and Fr. Mattingly will be gone for our annual retreat. I am grateful to Fr. Carlito who will be covering our confessions and noon Mass at Good Counsel while we are gone.

Canon Law states that religious, priests, and seminarians are bound to make a yearly retreat. While clergy and religious are required to do so, I believe a time of retreat each year is beneficial for everyone in the church. It is a real sacrifice for lay people who work full jobs and have other family commitments to use some of their vacation days to take a time of retreat. But a few days away to dialogue more intentionally with God, and without distraction, is critical for the person who is living Christian discipleship. St. Bernard once wrote:

"If you are wise, you will be reservoirs and not channels... the channels let the water flow away and do not retrain a drop. But the reservoir is first filled, and then, without emptying itself, pours out its overflow, which is ever renewed over the fields which it waters."

A retreat is a time to fill the reservoir. A time to examine how things are going and make resolutions for the upcoming year. In your kindness, please pray for Fr. Mattingly and myself during these days of retreat.

Last week I mentioned the Meitler study that the Diocese is currently doing while looking at downtown parishes and parishes in Independence. I will be hosting a meeting in the parish hall on Tuesday, February 1st at 6pm, where I will review the first draft of the Meitler proposal in detail and collect any feedback that you might have. Anyone is welcome to attend.
