# Veni, Sancte Spiritus

We celebrate the feast of Pentecost this weekend, the feast which some scholars and theologians consider the second most important feast day of the entire liturgical year. As I write this bulletin article, I reflect on all of the topics from which to choose to write about: Pentecost, naturally, or the month of June in which we celebrate in a special way the Sacred Heart of Jesus. I could write about the Eucharistic Revival which dioceses throughout our nation will kick-off on June 19th, The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. I could review a book or two regarding the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass and the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. So many topics from which to choose, and yet, today, my mind cannot escape the horrible atrocity which occurred on May 24th in Ulvade, Texas. 


