

## From Father Shofner

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Jesus' desire for us is first and foremost to know the Father, so that we might know His truth and love Him with a heart is singly focused on Him and on fulfilling His will. It's clear by the words that Jesus speaks to His disciples that in order to fulfill that desire, their hearts must be open to knowing the true peace that He brings. And the thing is, Jesus knows it's within their grasp, but their eyes are simply veiled from recognizing it. Why? Because of their sinfulness, their arrogance, their ignorance, their stubbornness, their self-interest, their lack of true faith and true surrender to God. And that saddens Him, because He knows the people's hearts are not then prepared for the assaults of the enemy. Many of them will have their faith shaken.

As in so many other things in our life, so it is with our faith. We fail to take the time or make the effort to truly prepare ourselves for what lies ahead. We tell ourselves that we'll just go with the flow and figure it out as we go along. But that can get us into trouble. I've known more than a few friends throughout high school and college who approached their studies this way. They figured they would just coast along throughout the semester and then cram it all in when a test came up. More often than not, it didn't end well. More serious is the case of a couple preparing for marriage, who thinks all they have to do is just "jump through all the hoops" that the parish asks so they can get to their wedding day and be married, but then a few years down the road they run into problems that threaten their marriage—if only they had taken their preparation time seriously, they would have had at least some of the tools they needed to address those problems. It's to our great benefit to prepare properly for the storms of life, even if we don't know what the nature of that storm may be. We must lay solid foundations now so that we're prepared for the future. And that takes time, effort and vigilance.

Jesus wants us to develop the spiritual skills necessary to deal with hardship, by fostering within ourselves a foundation of faith, hope, peace and charity. "If...you only knew what makes for peace," Jesus says (Luke 19:42). The necessary knowledge and skills come when we draw close to Christ and allow Him to teach us the way of peace, to understand that a heart that truly rests in the peace of Christ can withstand any storm. This peace He talks about is a state of the spirit, not a reflection of what's happening around us. It's an interior state, not swayed by external circumstances. How do we build up this spiritual foundation? By fostering the spiritual disciplines that we hear time and time again – reading His words to us as found in Holy Scripture, daily prayer, and frequent reception of the Sacraments (especially Confession and the Eucharist). Through these simple disciplines, grace is poured into our hearts, and God strengthens our spirits to face all things with the confidence that He will see us through. So often

we are blind to what makes for true peace, or else we ignore it. But our eyes do not have to remain hidden to the truth of what makes for peace, and our souls do not have to struggle when hard times arise—we *can* ask the Lord to prepare our hearts. And so, as I pray for you, please pray for one another: "Lord, pour our Your grace into our hearts, that You may set a firm foundation of strength from on high, readying us for the plan that You are unfolding in my life. In great confidence in Your loving, providential care, we pray. Amen."




