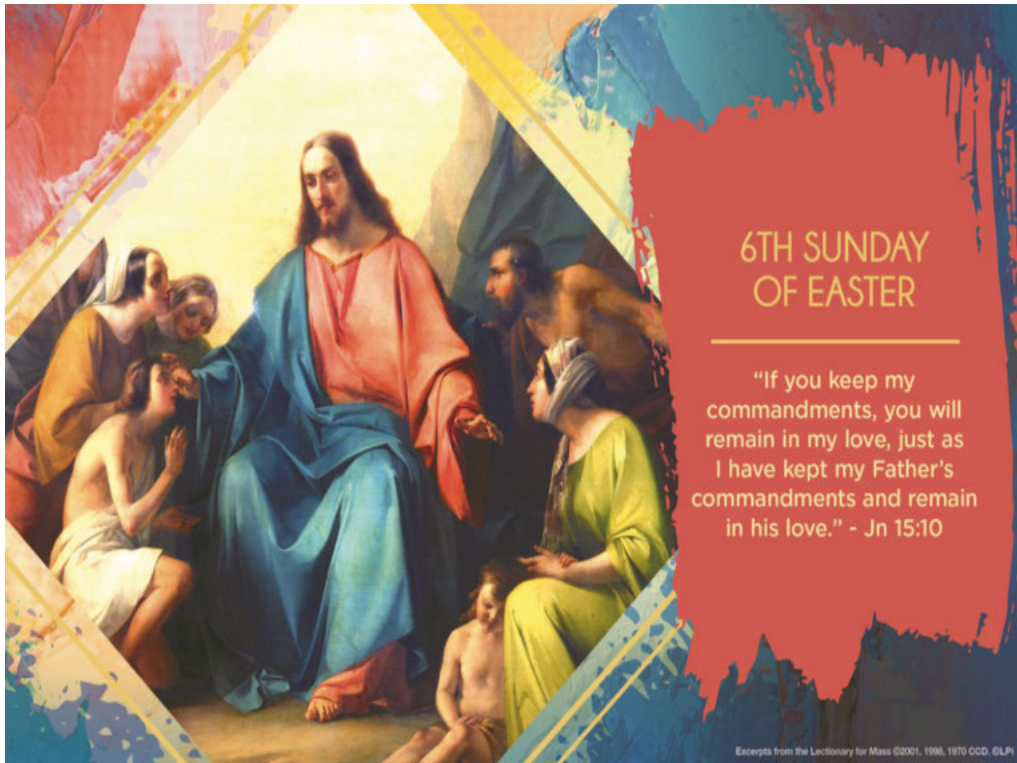

From Father Shofner

Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Exciting news is on the horizon for the Catholic Church. This past weekend the Dicastery for the Causes of Saints (the body that presents cases of those who are being considered for canonization as saints in the Church) announced the upcoming canonization of a young Italian man in 2025. Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, who was known for his profound faith, tireless service to the poor, and infectious joy, continues to inspire countless individuals around the world. While a specific date has not yet been set, the Church looks forward to this joyous occasion during the jubilee year of 2025. (A jubilee year has deep Jewish roots and was called every 50 years as a time of extraordinary mercy, forgiveness and solidarity. The Catholic Church adopted the practice of a jubilee year but holds them every 25 years, offering to the faithful special blessings.)

Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati is one of my favorite holy men of Church. When I first discovered him about 20 years ago, I was fascinated by his life story. He was born in Turin, Italy in 1901 into a prominent and wealthy family. Despite his privileged upbringing, Pier Giorgio embraced a life of simplicity and humility, following the teachings of Christ with unwavering devotion. Despite criticisms and strong resistance from his family, Pier Giorgio remained faithful to Christ. His deep love for the Eucharist and dedication to prayer sustained him through life's challenges and trials.

One of Pier Giorgio's most distinctive qualities was his commitment to serving the marginalized and disadvantaged in society. He spent much of his time volunteering in shelters, visiting the sick, and offering assistance to those in need. His family tried to dissuade him from serving the poor, as they saw it beneath their status as a family of renown, and his father saw it as a distraction from pursuing the life his father wanted for his son. It is well-known that when he graduated high school, his father gave him the choice of a car or money as a graduation gift. He chose the money and promptly distributed it to the poor. His compassion knew no bounds, and he viewed every person he encountered as a beloved child of God deserving of dignity and respect.

Pier Giorgio's love for the outdoors and adventurous spirit also reflected his profound spiritual life. He was known to be a mountain climber, often scaling the mountains surrounding Turin, finding solace and inspiration in the beauty of God's creation. His passion for nature served as a reminder of the majesty of the Creator and the importance of stewardship of the earth.

As a result of so much time spent with the sick and poor, he contracted polio and died at the young age of 24. Despite such a short life, Pier Giorgio left a lasting legacy of holiness and virtue, which his family was largely unaware of until

his funeral when thousands filled the streets to pay their respects. It was then that his family recognized the holiness of this young man. Pier Giorgio's impact on the world continues to reverberate. His witness challenges us to live our faith boldly, to seek out opportunities for service and charity, and to embrace joy in all circumstances.

As we anticipate Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati's canonization in 2025, let us take inspiration from his life and strive to follow his example of radical love and devotion to God. May his intercession strengthen our faith and lead us closer to Christ.

This coming Friday, May 10th, is the Mother's Day Sale. Thank you for all the donations! This event has been held for the students for 50+ years!

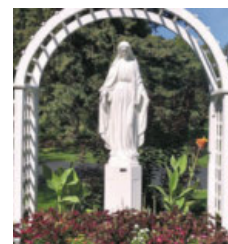
