Parts of the Catholic Mass Explained The opening prayer is the moment in which the priest invites the community to pray. At the beginning of the prayer, the priest says: "Let us pray" and extends his hands as a sign of appeal. This is a time to gather us all in silence and ask the Lord to help us. At the end of the prayer, all join what the priest asked, responding together: Amen! As the Lord tells us in the Gospel: "Again I say to you, if two of you agree on earth about anything they ask, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I in the midst of them," (Mt. 18:19-20). The opening prayer unites us with the universal Church, reminding us that in every corner of the world in which Mass is said, our brothers and sisters in Christ will be doing the same thing. One person's rejection of a cross brought sadness; the other's acceptance of it brought joy.

FEED MY NEIGHBOR FOOD PANTRY



During the months of April and May the food pantry fed 690 people, distributed 1250+ lbs. of food to 292 households. Serving folks of all ages, who are extremely appreciative.

The majority of our food is purchased through the St. Croix Valley Food Bank, and rescue food is retrieved from Balsam Lake Brewery, St. Croix Food Pantry, Walmart, Wayne's Foods Plus and other sources. In an effort to keep food out of the landfill, spoiled food is composted or provided to local farmers for their animals, i.e. chickens and hogs, when

appropriate. Funds for the pantry are mostly provided by the local community and grants have been applied for as well. If you would like to make a monetary donation or have any questions about the pantry please direct them to Our Lady of the Lakes office.

Food items that are always needed:

Ramen noodles, canned fruit, canned ravioli, spaghetti and meatballs, canned soup, canned chicken, spam, paper towels and toilet paper.
