A NOTE FROM FR. O'DELL

THE SYNOD

Synods are special meetings of the Church. Sometimes they just involve clergy. Sometimes they involve all members of the Church community. Sometimes they are for a particular diocese – sometimes for the Church world-wide. Beginning in February of this year, we will begin the process of gathering information from our parish and diocese to submit to the Holy Father in Rome – describing our perception of the direction of the Church in the near future. In addition, the Holy Father is asking us to develop a process to continue to discuss these important issues in the years to come.

The logical question for all of us is what will this process involve. Well, for many of us, it will involve going online and answering a series of questions that are designed to determine what you think is needful in the Church today. Some of the questions are choice questions – some of them will allow you to provide longer answers. I'm asking all of our parishioners to get online and take the survey. You are able to answer as much or as little as you desire on the survey. The period for response is between the first part of February and the end of the month. If you have difficulty with accessing the survey online, call the office and we will help you find a solution to the problem.

A second activity is a parish meeting that will be sponsored on January 31st at 7:00 P.M. You are all invited to attend to share your opinions. A sample of the survey questions will be available online for you to look over by January 16th. Please take some time to look them over and then plan on coming to the meeting. It is scheduled for 90 minutes.

Links to accessing the online survey and a sample of the survey questions will be available on the parish website in the very near future. The bottom line is, this will not be a difficult set of tasks. Please be generous and willing to provide your responses online and in person. This is an important opportunity to make your opinion and views known. Remember, we are all on this journey together.
