

Reflection from Father Steve

This weekend is the end of the Christmas Season. Christmas is not a one-day event, it is a season given to celebrate the truth and grace of the Christmas event.

For years the Season of Christmas ran from Christmas Eve to January 6th, the Epiphany. The period of time was known as Twelfth Night. A comedy of Shakespeare's bears the same name and is set in the Christmas Season.

In some cultures the Christmas Season extends to February 2nd, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord in the temple.

Between 1968 and 1978 I was at The Church of the Incarnation in South Minneapolis. Lavina Brecount, a parish member, lived at the end of the street. She was up in years, yet very active. She would host the last Christmas party of the neighborhood on the evening of February 2nd. It was a wonderful gathering. Ms. Brecount had an ulterior motive. Every nook and cranny of her house bore Christmas decorations. At the end of the party Lavina insisted that many hand make light work – she enlisted her guests to undecorated the house for her. Smart and clever lady!

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord is the inauguration of Jesus' public life. It is in the event of the baptism that the voice of the Father is heard to say: "This is my beloved Son on whom my favor rests. Listen to Him." The Spirit comes down on him and anoints Him as the Son of the Father.

In the baptism Jesus' destiny is announced. In your baptism you received your destiny as a son or daughter of the Father and sister or brother of Jesus. Baptism is the single most important religious event in any of our lives. The rest of the Christian life is the challenge to live out our baptism, to live out or destiny.

Do you have pictures from your baptism? Do you know when your baptism took place? If so, it might be a good idea to remember on the anniversary date each year your initiation into discipleship, in Baptism you were called to be a disciple of Jesus and a witness to the presence and action of God in our 21st century lives.


