

#### **Reflection from Father Steve**

Each year on January 22<sup>nd</sup> the Church observes the Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Children.

It is been for more than a generation that the "Abortion War" has been raging. The posture of the Pro-Abortion and the Pro-Life camps has hardened; no real dialogue or civil conversation takes place. As a result people mostly condemn each other and demonize each other.

In the early 70's, at the beginning of the abortion debate I found myself in a very uncomfortable position. I was strongly opposed to Roe v. Wade. I was a member of the steering committee of MCCL, along with Dr. Mechklenberg, Mrs. Hartel, and others.

At the same time I was vehemently opposed to the War in Vietnam and participated in anti-war demonstrations. My anti-war partners disowned me because of my anti-abortion stand; and my anti-abortion partners disowned me because of my anti-war stand.

It was only much later, March of 1984 that Cardinal Joseph Bernardin proposed a consistent ethic of life known as "The Seamless Garment of Life". Cardinal Bernardin stated at his address in Louisville, Kentucky:

"The Church is bound by sacred tradition to the proposition that all human beings, without any exception whatsoever, are made in the image and likeness of God and that Jesus Christ died for all human beings, without any exception whatsoever. Therefore each human person—without any exception whatsoever—is sacred and is the only creature that God wills for its own sake." Since then, the fundamental principle that governs the ethic of human life must be measured against this consistent ethic of life.

We all owe a debt of gratitude to Cardinal Bernardin for the clarification so deeply needed then, and so deeply needed today.

#### **Faith Formation News**

Faith Formation Class Schedule: Faith Formation students in grades K-10 have in-person classes on Wednesday, January 26. On Wednesday, February 2, ONLY students preparing for First Reconciliation and First Communion have class; all other students do not have class that evening. On February 2, First Communion students will meet in church and at least one parent needs to attend with the student preparing for First Communion. On Wednesday, February 9, all Faith Formation students are off and do NOT have class. Regular weekly classes resume on February 16 in the Parish Center.




