

# 18TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

## GOSPEL MEDITATION

August 1, 2021

18th Sunday in Ordinary Time

“You cannot see the forest for the trees” is a widely known saying that can bring wisdom to our understanding of our journey. Often, our sight becomes limited to what is immediately before us. We lose touch with lessons and experiences from the past and promises and hope for the future. As human beings, we have the privilege of being able to choose things. What I like and don’t like, want, and don’t want can be major preoccupations of our minds and hearts. Our preferences and desires begin to define us more than the simple fact of our being. Who we are matters more than what we are or what we have. If we don’t move beyond the external and superficial stuff to what really is of essence, we risk becoming very unsettled, disoriented, angry, and unhappy. We fail to see the bigger picture of hope and promise that lies ahead and the Divine Presence that has sustained and carried us before.

We like it when the “now” times of our lives satisfy us. Even the people who witnessed Jesus feed the five thousand got confused and distracted. It felt good when thousands of people were able to eat. They wanted to know what they could do to get this to happen again! But Jesus quickly reminds them that this is not the point of this sign. As much as the now time of our lives is of concern, it is not what is ultimately important. We need to learn the difference between being and doing, drawing more strength from who we are and who God is rather than what is happening around us and the choices we can make. Jesus is the true bread that came down from heaven. Jesus is the very incarnate presence of God who sustains life and assures us that we will not perish. This is not easy to understand and feel. We have to practice being in the presence of ourselves, others, creation, and God. We are brought to a holy place when we encounter the sacredness of being. This is real prayer.

Then, we learn to trust. It is when we cease trusting that we start to become afraid, uncertain, apprehensive, doubtful, and overly self-concerned. We even start to grumble. God has our back. That is the essential powerful message of the living bread come down from heaven. God, who is alpha is also omega, the beginning and the end, and has everything in between in his care as well. A woman once remarked that her most powerful God moment happened when she and her husband cuddled with their new baby for a time. Without exchanging words and using only the affection communicated through sight and touch, they rested in being with each other. This brought them to the sacred, where they realized that a greater Being was with them. It was real. They knew that they were part of something bigger, intimate, and profound. When we rest in the Living Source of life, we will find that our souls are no longer hungry or thirsty.

## SCHOOL OF RELIGION REGISTRATION TIME

For all parents whose children attend public grade school in the Kindergarten through Eighth grades, please note that Religious Education classes in our School of Religion will begin at 11:00 am on Sunday, September 12, 2021.

- Early Bird Registration fees, which expire after August 31st, are \$85 for one student, \$110 for two students, and \$120 for three or more students. On September 1st, prices are then returned to \$100, \$125, and \$135, respectively.
- Fr. Bill believes strongly that children currently enrolled in grades Kindergarten through Eight should receive formal Religious Education, not only in sacramental years, but every year.
- Preparation and instruction for First Holy Communion and Confirmation begin in First and Seventh grades, respectively, and run for two years.

## JOB POSTING: WEDDING COORDINATOR

Saint Agnes Parish seeks to hire a Wedding Coordinator, and below is a brief outline and description of duties.

The Wedding Coordinator represents the parish at all weddings at Saint Agnes. The coordinator meets with the bride and groom approximately two months prior to the wedding date to:

- discuss the ceremony
- assist in making arrangements for the church
- answer any questions regarding the liturgy
- answer any wedding day questions

The Coordinator also works with the priest to conduct the rehearsal and helps to coordinate:

- the binder which will hold the selected readings and Universal Prayers for the Mass
- the wedding party on the ceremony day
- any floral or other sacramental needs and ensure the Church is returned to the physical status in which it was found prior to the wedding
- the opening of doors for the wedding party to access the church, turning lights on prior to the wedding party's arrival, and turning lights off and locking church doors after the event
- The Coordinator is expected to remain at the church until after the wedding party has departed.

If the wedding couple has hired an outside wedding consultant, he or she is welcome at Saint Agnes; however, the Parish Wedding Coordinator is responsible for the liturgy and all things at Saint Agnes. If the outside wedding consultant is present for the ceremony, his or her function is only to assist the bride or groom personally.

The Coordinator represents the Parish and should be kind and courteous to the bride and groom, their families and the wedding party. Punctuality is essential when meeting with the bride and groom and when arriving for the wedding rehearsal and wedding ceremony. On the day of the wedding, the Coordinator should be professionally attired.


