





Epiphany Blessing of the Chalk

The Church has a custom of blessing homes on the Feast of the Epiphany and the week following. Family and friends gather to ask God's blessing on their homes and those who visit the home. It is an invitation for Jesus to be a daily guest in our home, our comings and goings, our conversations, our work and play, our joys and sorrows.

A traditional way of doing this is to use chalk blessed during the Epiphany liturgy and write above the homes entryway,

20 + C + M + B + 22. The letters C, M, B, have two meanings. They are initials of the traditional names of the three Magi:

Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. They also abbreviate the Latin words Christus mansionem benedicat, "May Christ bless the house."

The "+" signs represent the cross and 2022 is the year.

As you are writing the blessing, pray one of the following prayers:

May all who come to our home this year rejoice to find Christ living among us; and may we seek and serve, in everyone we meet, that same

Jesus who is Lord, forever and ever. 1

or

by the guidance of a star. Bless this house and all who inhabit it. Fill us with the Light of Christ, that our only concern for others may reflect Your Love.

We ask this through Christ our Lord.

or

Lord our God, bless this household. May we be blessed with health, goodness of heart, gentleness, and the keeping of Your law. We give thanks to You, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, now and forever.
