## MARRIAGE


Registered members of the parish must call the rectory and speak with Fr. Bill at least 6 months prior to your proposed wedding date.



#### KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS BABY SHOWER: JAN 2ND - FEB 7TH


The annual Knights of Columbus Baby Shower to benefit the Olathe and Wyandotte Pregnancy Centers will run through the month of January.


### ST. MARY'S FOOD KITCHEN


#### WOMEN OF SAINT AGNES
