Happy New Year everyone!

Thank you for your generous donations to the Angel Tree! You donated \$1943 and we are extremely grateful.

St. Vincent de Paul's fiscal year ends in September, followed by our annual audit in December. Last year we received a total of \$26,370 in donations. Our largest donation came from the St Vincent de Paul store in Spearfish for \$9000. As you can see, donations to the St. Vincent de Paul store come back to benefit us and "Our Friends in Need." Other significant donations came with matching funds from Modern Woodmen and Immanuel Lutheran Church in Whitewood. Lastly, we received a grant of \$5000 from the Sturgis Rally and Races.

We distributed \$28,334 to "Our Friends In Need" in 2021, most of which was paid toward rent and electric utilities. Other expenses were for food, gas, medicine, car repairs, water bills and bus passes.
