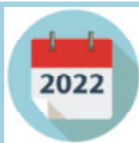

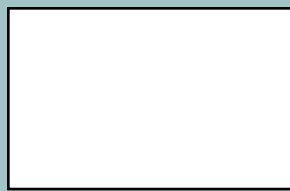
#### Courage | EnCourage


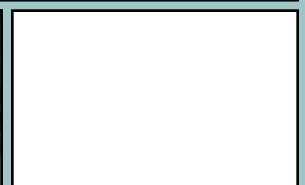
