Life Principles Academy, a Healing the Culture workshop


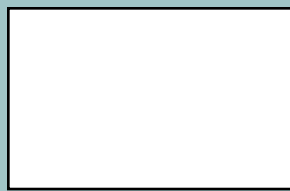


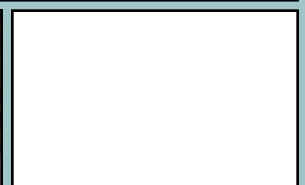
