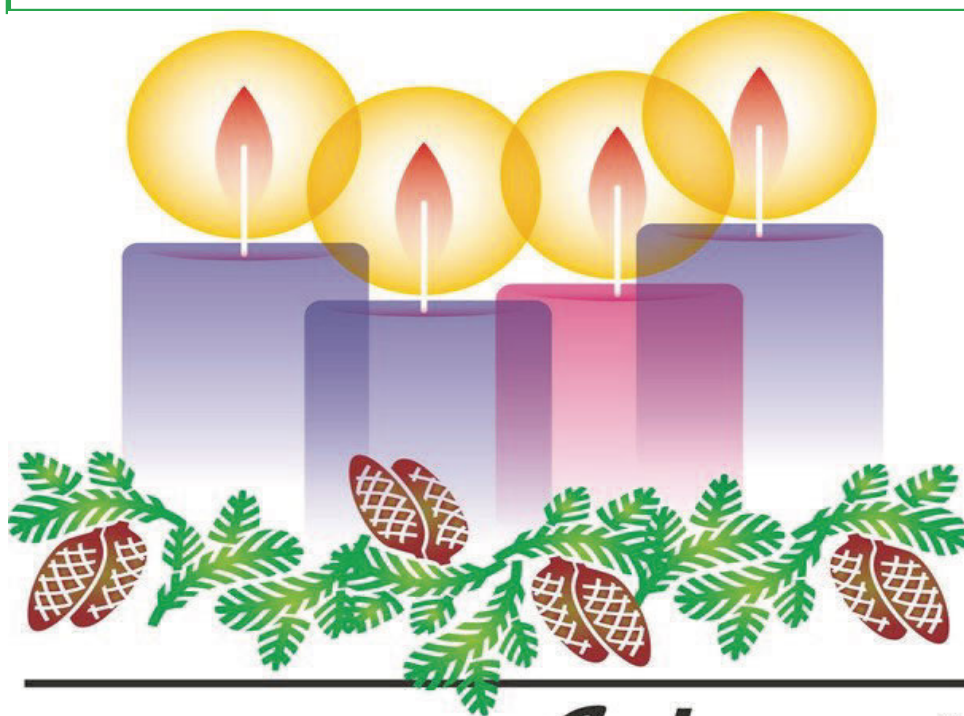

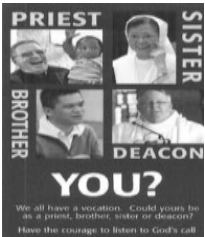

Safe Environment Updates

The Safe Environment office is currently in the process of changing the training requirements from an in-person model to fully online training modules through CMG Connect. The Diocese will be also switching background check processing from Mind Your Business to a company called Selection. An individual will be able to complete the SET training through the CMG Connect website and will also be given an option to enter their information to complete their background check through the same online system. Safe Environment Coordinators will then be able to go login to CMG Connect to see that all the steps have been completed and find background results all in one place! Currently, the SET training is in place with the background check connection in progress. We hope to have it up and running by the first of December.

The youth training is also being updated with a program called Circle of Grace, for grades K-12. This program was developed by the Archdiocese of Omaha and is used by 35 other Catholic Diocese around the country. Each parish will need these resources to participate in these programs next Fall.
