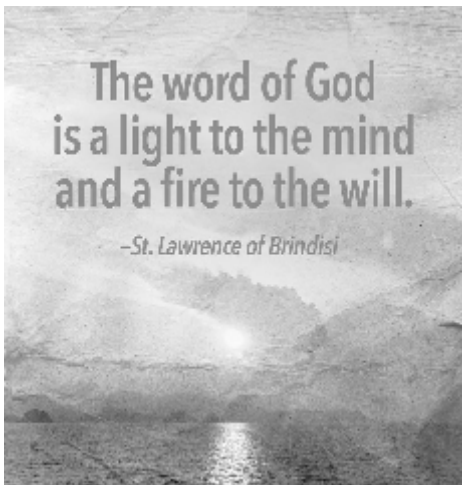

MESSAGES FROM FATHER COON

- The rectory phone is currently out of service. When you call the number, it will sound like it is ringing, but it is not ringing in the rectory. To speak with Fr. Coon by phone, please call the Parish Office at 624-7333; if he is not there at the time, please leave a message, and he will return your call.
- On Wednesday June 30, Bishop Rice reminded the clergy that we and all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are to wear masks while distributing Holy Communion. Anyone is welcome to wear a mask during Mass. However, please pull the mask down from your face before you are presented with the Body of Christ so that you don't have to try and hold the Sacred Body of Christ and risk dropping Him while at the same time lowering your mask.
- So far, seven parishioners have volunteered to drive Fr. either to our parishioners who are homebound, in nursing homes, in area hospitals, and to his Mama's house in Charleston. If you could be added to the list of either taking Fr. to our parishioners or to his Mama's, please call the Parish Office at 624-7333 and leave a message. As previously announced, drivers to parishioners will be paid by the parish, and drivers to Fr.'s Mama's will be paid by Fr.
- A special word of thanks to Phyllis Dambach who has offered to cook part-time for Fr. If anyone would be willing to share this ministry with her by taking a week or two a month, she would greatly appreciate it. Please call Father at 624-7333. Two or three meals would be needed per week with enough food available for leftovers. Individuals will be paid \$20 for each meal they prepare. Food can be prepared either in the person's home or at the rectory. Food would be for the evening meal but can be brought or prepared anytime; Father can heat it whenever he is ready for it. A list of foods that Father likes will be giving to anyone who can assist with this ministry.
- Fr. is excited to work with anyone who may be interested in becoming Catholic. Be the voice of Christ and encourage someone you know to consider becoming part of our Catholic family or at least to come and find out more about us through our formation sessions. Interested individuals are asked to contact Fr. at 624-7333 by Sunday August 1.
- In order for people to make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament during the day, Fr. is keeping the single wooden door on the west side of the church unlocked during daylight hours.
- If you have been considering having a Spiritual Director and would like to hear how Fr. approaches individual spiritual direction, feel free to call him at 624-7333 and set up a meeting to talk about it.
- If you are in need of an annulment or have any other special situation that needs care, please feel free to call Fr. at 624-7333; he will be happy to meet with you about it.
- Fr. is very pleased that there are people coming to Mass on Mondays, Thursdays, and Fridays. He realizes that people have not been in the habit of going to Mass on these days because Mass was not possible on those days with other parishes needing to be served. It is wonderful to see that those whose schedules allow time for morning Mass are forming new habits and coming to Mass more often.
- As a reminder, Fr. doesn't recognize people well, so please tell him your name when starting a conversation with him. He doesn't want to appear cold and unfriendly by not calling you by name.
- As Fr. announced his first weekend, he sees well enough to very easily and comfortably give Holy Communion on the tongue to those who prefer to receive our Lord that way.
- If you know of any parishioner who is homebound or in an area nursing home, please let Fr. Coon know by calling 624-7333 so that he can visit them on a regular basis.
- Fr. is in need of an additional volunteer to clean the rectory once a month. For more information or to volunteer, please call Fr at 624-7333.
