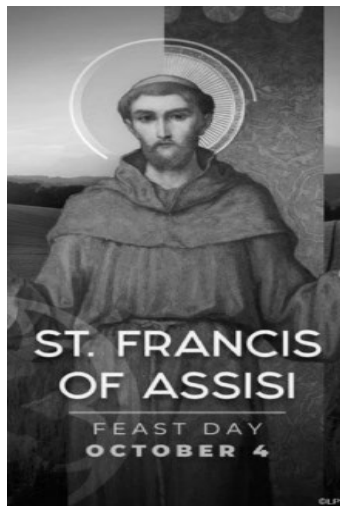

MESSAGES FROM FATHER COON

- **EXPANDED TIMES FOR THE SACRAMENT OF CONFESSION** Because Fr. is here full-time, he is able to expand our parish Confession schedule. This beautiful Sacrament to celebrate our Lord's mercy and strength to grow in the Christian virtues is now available at the following times. Saturdays 3:15 to 3:45, Sundays 7:00 to 7:20, immediately following 10:30 Mass, Wednesday from 4:15 to 4:55, and anytime by appointment.
- **DEVOTION TO OUR BLESSED MOTHER BRINGS US CLOSER TO JESUS.** When the new Church year begins the weekend of November 27 and 28, let us begin to pray the Rosary before our weekend Masses. The Rosary would begin 30 minutes before each Mass. If you would be willing to be put on a schedule to lead the Rosary at a particular Mass time, please sign the sheet in the vestibule of the church. You may want to lead it by yourself, or with one or more family members, or with one or more friends. Our Lord will truly bless us and our parish with a deeper relationship to Himself by increasing our devotion to His sweet Mother.
- **PAID POSITION AVAILABLE AT SACRED HEART** Fr. Coon and the Finance Council are seeking someone to clean the rectory twice a month. For more information regarding the salary and other details, please contact Fr. or a Finance Council member by Monday October 11.
- Fr. will offer another review session to already trained Altar Servers during the PSR period next Sunday, October 10. If you would like to have your already trained Altar Server be present for this session and then to begin Serving again, please let Fr. know by calling the Parish Office this week at 624-7333 or by sending a note to your Server's PSR teacher next Sunday.
- If you have not updated your family's contact information, update cards remain in the vestibule of the church. Please fill out a card and place it in the collection basket.
- While all are certainly welcome to wear masks during Mass, please remove your mask just before you are presented with the Body of Christ at Holy Communion. This will make for a reverent reception of our Lord and will diminish the possibility of dropping Him if you receive Him directly on your hand. Thank you.
- If you know of any parishioner who is homebound or in an area nursing home, please let Fr. Coon know by calling 624-7333 so that he can visit them on a regular basis.
- In order for people to make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament during the day, Fr. is keeping the single wooden door on the west side of the church unlocked during daylight hours.
- As a reminder, Fr. doesn't recognize people well, so please tell him your name when starting a conversation with him. He doesn't want to appear cold and unfriendly by not calling you by name.

TURKEY DINNER CANCELLATION

You may have heard by now that a decision has been made to cancel the turkey dinner this year. This decision was not made lightly and it involved key members of the crews responsible for various aspects of the dinner operation. There is still uncertainty about the virus and many on our work schedule are in the vulnerable population and there are concerns about a super spreader event. It was in the interest of safety that the decision was made to hold off again one more year. Thank you for your understanding.

A MESSAGE FROM THE FINANCE COUNCIL

For the first time in 18 years, our parish has a full-time Pastor who is not responsible for any other parishes and will be able to give us his undivided attention. This also means that no other parishes will be helping us with the financial support that Pastors receive from the parishes where they serve. Therefore, we are solely responsible for Fr. Coon's monthly salary set by the Bishop, Fr.'s annual health insurance, and his needs in the rectory which consist mainly of food, water, and utilities. The Parish Finance Council believes that if parishioners who are able will increase their weekly Sunday offering by \$3 to \$5, we should have no problem meeting these additional expenses to our parish. This increase in giving will also help to pay the salary of our part-time Parish Administrator.
