

# MESSAGES FROM FATHER COON

- We have two Holy Days of Obligation in the next week. The first is Christmas with our Masses being at 4:00 p.m. Friday and at midnight and 9:00 a.m. Saturday. Our second is, as usual, next Sunday with all of those Masses being on Sunday at 7:30 a.m., 10:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Please note that there is no 4:00 p.m. Mass next Saturday. Catholics are obligated to celebrate both of the Holy Days of Obligation. Celebrating just one of them does not suffice for both. As always, it is a serious sin to deliberately miss any Holy Days of Obligation which includes all Sundays of the year.
- A PERSONAL NOTE FROM FR. I know that there are those in our parish family who are experiencing your first Christmas without a loved one because since last year that loved one has died. Please be assured of my prayers for you these days that you experience the comfort and consolation that only the God of Life can give. May this Advent and Christmas Season renew your hope in the eternal life of Heaven that Jesus was born to bring.
- NEW MASS AND ADORATION TIME On Wednesdays, Mass will now be at 12:00 noon. Eucharistic Adoration will be from 1:00 to 7:00. Confession will be from 6:00 to 6:30. If you would like Eucharistic Adoration to be extended later than 7:00 so that you could more easily come, please let Fr. Coon know by calling him in the Parish Office at 624-7333.
- SOMETHING NEW FOR US AT SACRED HEART From Friday December 17 through Thursday
  December 23rd from 7:00 to 7:30 p.m., Fr. will offer what is called The Christmas Novena. It
  is a 30 minute prayer service consisting of hymns, a Scripture reading, and other prayers
  that are meant to help us make final spiritual preparations for Christmas. It is a quiet, reflective, peaceful time. All are invited and encouraged to come as often as you can. Fr. will
  also be available for the Sacrament of Reconciliation each evening after the Novena.
- CALLING ALL WHO HAVE MADE CURSILLO RECENTLY OR IN THE PAST Fr. would like to
  gather with all those who have made Cursillo to see if there is interest in coming together
  perhaps once or twice a month for the Group Reunion portion of our Fourth Day. Fr. is excited about this opportunity. Our meeting to discuss this possibility will be Monday January
  17 at 6:30 in the St. Margaret Mary Alacoque Room.
- A sincere word of thanks to those who have volunteered to lead the Rosary before our
  weekend Masses. The response has been very good. Mary desires only to bring us closer
  to her Son, and praying her Rosary helps that to happen in a tremendous way. If you would
  still like to volunteer to lead before a particular Mass time, please call Karl in the Parish
  Office. Thank you.
- A MESSAGE TO ALL USHERS Thank you for your ministry of welcome and service to our parish family and to visitors. To continue providing a welcoming environment to our parishioners and to visitors, on your assigned weekends, please try to come to church about ten minutes before Mass. Fr. asks that before Mass each assigned usher stand inside the vestibule near one of the outside church doors. As people approach from outside, please open the door and offer a greeting to them. After Mass, please distribute bulletins as people are leaving. If you have any questions, please check with Fr.
- While all are certainly welcome to wear masks during Mass, please remove your mask just before you are presented with the Body of Christ at Holy Communion. This will make for a reverent reception of our Lord and will diminish the possibility of dropping Him if you receive Him directly on your hand. Thank you.
